WHEREAS, an advocate for promoting reconciliation, equipping 26 27 servant leaders and educating the next generation, Pastor Cathey 28 is actively involved in his community, including serving as Second 29 Vice President of the General Missionary Baptist State Convention 30 of Mississippi, previously serving as a board member of the United Way of Southeast Mississippi, the Hattiesburg American Editorial 31 32 Board, the Salvation Army Advisory Board, and the Board of Trustees for the Mississippi Baptist Seminary and Bible College, 33 34 and serving as a member of the Area Development Partnership's 35 Leaders for a New Century, now known as Leadership Pinebelt, Class 36 of 2000; and
