- 6 WHEREAS, the Hattiesburg High School Lady Tigers Basketball
- 7 Team reign supreme after finishing the 2017-2018 season with an
- 8 impressive record of 26 wins and 6 losses, and capturing the
- 9 Mississippi High School Activities Association (MHSAA) Girls Class
- 10 5A State Basketball Championship, their first title in the
- 11 school's history; and
- 12 WHEREAS, throughout the state tournament games at the
- 13 Mississippi Coliseum, the Lady Tigers played with clear eyes, full
- 14 hearts and unimaginable amounts of strength, and in each game,
- 15 their mental stamina and athletic prowess never wavered from the
- 16 moment they first hustled onto the court until the final buzzer
- 17 buzzed, as they outlasted, outplayed and ultimately overpowered
- 18 the Laurel Tornadoes 68-49 in the second round, the Neshoba
- 19 Central Lady Rockets 48-38 in the quarterfinals, the Lafayette

- 20 Lady Commodores 56-42 in the semifinals and the West Jones Lady
- 21 Mustangs 48-47 in the championship game; and
- 22 WHEREAS, to claim this illustrious victory, the Lady Tigers
- 23 relied on their swift feet, accurate shooting and strategic
- 24 defensive moves to stop the West Jones offense and outmaneuver
- 25 their defense, which ultimately allowed them to bring the coveted
- 26 "Gold Ball" Trophy back to Hattiesburg High School for the first
- 27 time after so many close title games; and
- 28 WHEREAS, the championship game truly kept fans on their feet
- 29 and the edge of their seats until the very end, and in the last 14
- 30 seconds of play, it looked as if West Jones, who had the ball and
- 31 a one-point lead, would be crowned champions, but the Tigers were
- 32 absolutely not going to succumb to defeat, so they fought to the
- 33 very last second, and it paid off; and
- 34 WHEREAS, when West Jones tried to inbound the ball after a
- 35 Hattiesburg turnover, Hattiesburg player Kenedi Walker made just
- 36 enough contact with the ball to nudge it out of the West Jones'
- 37 player's hand, and the ball landed at the feet of surprised and
- 38 determined Chelsea Ulmer; and
- 39 WHEREAS, with just three seconds left on the clock, Chelsea
- 40 picked up the ball, turned around, shot, and then swoosh, just
- 41 like that, the hard work and dedication of the 2017-2018 Lady
- 42 Tigers culminated into the first state championship for the
- 43 Hattiesburg High School Girls Basketball Team and deservedly, an
- 44 excited dog pile on the floor of the Mississippi Coliseum; and

45	WHEREAS, the 2017-2018 MHSAA Class 5A Girls Basketball State
46	Championship Team is comprised of only talented athletes, and in
47	addition to winning the coveted state championship, the Lady
48	Tigers clinched the Region 7 regular season championship by going
49	undefeated in district play and won the Region 7 district
50	tournament championship, Terralyn Ulmer was named the Region 7
51	MVP, Melyia Grayson was named the best defensive player, and Coach
52	Caronica DeBose Jackson was named the Region 7 Coach of the Year;

54	WHEREAS, the Hattiesburg High School Lady Tigers Basketball
55	Team has been superbly coached and inspired by Head Coach Caronica
56	DeBose Jackson, who has broadened the players' knowledge of the
57	game, refined their skills in execution, and helped each player
