19 known as the AquaBots, were the Excellence award winners; and

21 Madeline Seal and Faith Guy, known as the Chili Bots, qualified

23 WHEREAS, the Twin Bots and AquaBots are currently ranked in
24 the top 50 teams worldwide out of 3,000 teams; and
