HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 95

1 A RESOLUTION COMMENDING THE PHENOMENAL APPROACH TO 2 EDUCATIONAL ADMINISTRATION, BUILDING EDUCATOR MORALE AND 3 EMPHASIZING STUDENT ENGAGEMENT OF DR. ROBYN KILLEBREW, PRINCIPAL 4 OF PASS CHRISTIAN HIGH SCHOOL IN PASS CHRISTIAN, MISSISSIPPI, AND CONGRATULATING HER UPON RECEIVING A 2017 MILKEN EDUCATOR AWARD. 5 6 WHEREAS, on Friday, January 19, 2018, Dr. Robyn Killebrew, 7 principal at Pass Christian High School, in Pass Christian, 8 Mississippi, for the last four years, became a Milken Educator 9 when she was named one of a select few in a class of prestigious 10 recipients awarded the nationally renowned Milken Educator Award for 2017 and a \$25,000 unrestricted cash prize incentive; and 11 12 WHEREAS, revered by her fellow educators as an administrator with the rare ability to engage individual students, Dr. 13 14 Killebrew, a twelve-year teaching veteran and third-generation 15 educator following the footsteps of her grandmother and mother, has perfected the skill of adapting her team approach to 16 17 administration to encompass methods that build upon the concerted efforts of educators and students alike, as indicated by her 18 implementation of Pass Christian's Freshmen Academy, which is 19

20 specifically designed to ease the transition of students from 21 middle school to ninth grade; and

22 WHEREAS, a former basketball, softball and volleyball coach, 23 "Coach K," as she is affectionately called by her students, is 24 described as a "whatever it takes" leader, taking on the most 25 menial of tasks to ensure the best for her students, from driving school buses unable to finish their routes, to personally 26 27 chauffeuring and chaperoning student volunteers in humanitarian 28 efforts in the wake of the Baton Rouge flood, serving as both administrator and number one fan to each extracurricular 29 30 organization, visiting the homes of at-risk students and inviting the community to her monthly "Pastries with the Principal"; and 31

32 WHEREAS, a 2003 graduate of William Carey University, Dr. Killebrew, who earned both her masters in sports administration 33 34 and a PhD in educational leadership and administration from the 35 University of Mississippi in 2006 and 2016 respectively, who 36 tutors three days per week and participates on several committees, does not lay claim to any extraordinary talent, has witnessed the 37 38 school's graduation rate rise to over 90%, report an increase on 39 the ACT with students meeting their benchmark on all four testing 40 areas from 17% to 27% since creating an ACT "boot camp," being selected in 2016 by U.S. News and World Report as the No. 1 high 41 school in the state, having an "A" accountability rating and a 42 43 Value Added Award recipient by the State Department of Education; 44 and

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45 WHEREAS, the Milken Educator Awards are the preeminent 46 educator acknowledgement program in the nation and has honored more than 2,500 K-12 teachers, principals and specialists across 47 48 the country; and

49 WHEREAS, founded by Mr. Lowell Milken to celebrate, promote 50 and stimulate commendable K-12 educators, and to publicly demonstrate that excellence in education must be acknowledged and 51 52 rewarded, the Milken Educator Awards program strives to 53 communicate to parents and policymakers the established truth that 54 the quality of the educator is the most important factor in 55 determining student achievement; and

56 WHEREAS, although the Milken Educator Awards have no formal 57 application or nomination process, each participating state's department of education appoints an independent committee to 58 59 recommend contenders based upon strict standards, with final 60 recipient selections made by the Milken Family Foundation; and

61 WHEREAS, the Milken Educator Awards are known throughout the education profession as the "Oscars of Teaching," catching each 62 63 recipient by surprise, and on the afternoon of Friday, January 19, 64 2018, Dr. Robyn Killebrew was inducted into the Milken Educator 65 Network of premier hall of famers, a network that is dedicated to 66 improving and strengthening K-12 education in America; and

67 WHEREAS, it is the policy of the House of Representatives to 68 commend outstanding individuals, such as Dr. Robyn Killebrew, 69 whose outstanding rapport with her fellow colleagues and, more

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importantly, with her students, translates into an impassioned zeal for transforming, enriching and positively molding the lives of those under her tutelage and instruction, past, present and future:
