- SECTION 1. Section 97-15-37, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 5
- amended as follows: 6
- 7 97-15-37. (1) If any person shall fell any bush or tree
- into any public road or highway, or obstruct the same in any 8
- 9 manner whatever, and shall not remove the obstruction immediately,
- except as provided in subsection (2), it shall be deemed a 10
- 11 misdemeanor, and, on conviction thereof the offender, in addition
- 12 to the penalty recoverable by law, shall be fined not more than
- Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) or be imprisoned not more than one (1) 13
- 14 week.
- 15 (2) If the violation of this section constitutes an
- 16 intentional act of malice, including, but not limited to, a person
- sitting, standing or lying in a public road or highway that would 17
- 18 impede or hinder the passage of emergency vehicles, the violation

- 19 shall be a misdemeanor punishable by a fine not to exceed One
- 20 Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) or imprisonment not to exceed six (6)
- 21 months, or both.
- 22 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 23 and after July 1, 2018.
