SENATE BILL NO. 2098

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTIONS 63-1-35 AND 45-35-3, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REQUIRE THE DESIGNATION OF CERTAIN DISABILITIES ON DRIVER'S LICENSES AND IDENTIFICATION CARDS UNDER CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES; TO REQUIRE TRAINING FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS IN RECOGNIZING CERTAIN MENTAL OR MEDICAL CONDITIONS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

- 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 8 **SECTION 1.** Section 63-1-35, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 9 amended as follows:
- 10 63-1-35. (1) The Commissioner of Public Safety shall
- 11 prescribe the form of license issued pursuant to this article
- 12 which shall, among other features, include a driver's license
- 13 number assigned by the Department of Public Safety. A licensee
- 14 shall list his social security number with the department which
- 15 shall cross-reference the social security number with the driver's
- 16 license number for purposes of identification. Additionally, each
- 17 license shall bear a full-face color photograph of the licensee in
- 18 such form that the license and the photograph cannot be separated.
- 19 The photograph shall be taken so that one (1) exposure will

20 photograph the applicant and the application simultaneously on the

- 21 same film. The department shall use a process in the issuance of
- 22 a license with a color photograph that shall prevent as nearly as
- 23 possible any alteration, counterfeiting, duplication,
- 24 reproduction, forging or modification of the license or the
- 25 superimposition of a photograph without ready detection. The
- 26 photograph shall be replaced by the department at the time of
- 27 renewal. Drivers' licenses, including photographs appearing
- 28 thereon, may be renewed by electronic means according to rules and
- 29 regulations promulgated by the commissioner in conformity to
- 30 Section 27-104-33.
- 31 (2) The commissioner shall prescribe the form of license
- 32 issued pursuant to this article to licensees who are not United
- 33 States citizens and who do not possess a social security number
- 34 issued by the United States government. The license of such
- 35 persons shall include a number and/or other identifying features.
- 36 (3) Any new, renewal or duplicate driver's license,
- 37 temporary driving permit, intermediate license or commercial
- 38 driver's license issued to a person required to register as a sex
- 39 offender pursuant to Section 45-33-25 shall bear a designation
- 40 identifying the licensee or permittee as a sex offender.
- 41 (4) The commissioner is authorized to provide the new,
- 42 renewal or duplicate driver's license, temporary driving permit,
- 43 intermediate license or commercial driver's license to any
- 44 honorably discharged veteran as defined in Title 38 of the United
- 45 States Code, and such license or permit shall exhibit the letters

- 46 "Vet" or any other mark identifying the person as a veteran.
- veteran requesting the "Vet" designation shall present his DD-214 47
- or equivalent document that includes a notation from the State 48
- 49 Veterans Affairs Board that the applicant is a veteran.
- 50 (5) Upon the presentation by the applicant of a letter
- 51 signed by a physician or psychologist who is licensed to practice
- in Mississippi verifying that the applicant is diagnosed with a 52
- 53 pervasive developmental disorder, the new, renewal or duplicate
- 54 driver's license, temporary driving permit, intermediate license
- 55 or commercial driver's license issued to the person shall exhibit
- 56 the letters "PDD" identifying the licensee or permittee as a
- 57 person who has a pervasive developmental disorder.
- 58 SECTION 2. Section 45-35-3, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- amended as follows: 59
- 45-35-3. (1) Any person six (6) years of age or older may 60
- 61 be issued an identification card by the department which is
- 62 certified by the registrant and attested by the commissioner as to
- 63 true name, correct age and such other identifying data as required
- 64 by Section 45-35-5.
- 65 The new, renewal or duplicate identification card of a
- 66 person required to register as a sex offender pursuant to Section
- 67 45-33-25 shall bear a designation identifying the cardholder as a
- sex offender. 68
- 69 The commissioner is authorized to provide the new,
- 70 renewal or duplicate identification card to any honorably

/l discharged veteran as defined in Title 38 of the United Sta

- 72 Code, and such identification card shall exhibit the letters "Vet"
- 73 or any other mark identifying the person as a veteran. The
- 74 veteran requesting the "Vet" designation shall present his DD-214
- 75 or equivalent document that includes a notation from the State
- 76 Veterans Affairs Board that the applicant is a veteran.
- 77 (4) Upon the presentation by the applicant of a letter
- 78 signed by a physician or psychologist who is licensed to practice
- 79 in Mississippi verifying that the applicant is diagnosed with a
- 80 pervasive developmental disorder, the new, renewal or duplicate
- 81 identification card issued to the person shall exhibit the letters
- 82 "PDD" identifying the holder as a person who has a pervasive
- 83 developmental disorder.
- 84 **SECTION 3.** The Board on Law Enforcement Officer Standards
- 85 and Training shall promulgate regulations to require education and
- 86 training components on mental health and behavioral issues to
- 87 consist of not less than six (6) hours in the initial law
- 88 enforcement officer certification program and not less than one
- 89 (1) hour in any required continuing education program for law
- 90 enforcement officers. The behavioral component will train
- 91 officers to recognize behavioral characteristics that distinguish
- 92 conditions such as autism, Asperger's syndrome, or any other
- 93 mental or medical condition that may present with atypical
- 94 developmental symptoms that are not developmentally typical which
- 95 could be perceived by an untrained person as suspicious.

96 **SECTION 4.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 97 and after July 1, 2018.
