SENATE BILL NO. 2561

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 25-43-3.108, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REVISE THE MAXIMUM NUMBER OF DAYS FOR WHICH A TEMPORARY RULE MAY BE EFFECTIVE UNDER THE ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURES ACT; AND

4 FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 **SECTION 1.** Section 25-43-3.108, Mississippi Code of
- 7 1972, is amended as follows:
- 8 25-43-3.108. Exemption from public rule-making procedures
- 9 for temporary rules.
- 10 If an agency finds that an imminent peril to the public
- 11 health, safety or welfare requires adoption of a rule upon fewer
- 12 than twenty-five (25) days' notice and states in writing its
- 13 reasons for that finding, it may proceed without prior notice of
- 14 hearing or upon any abbreviated notice and hearing that it finds
- 15 practicable to adopt an emergency rule. The rule may be effective
- 16 for a period of not longer than * * * ninety (90) days, renewable
- 17 once for a period not exceeding * * * sixty (60) days, but the
- 18 adoption of an identical rule under * * * this Article III is not
- 19 precluded.

- 20 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 21 and after July 1, 2018.
