- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 **SECTION 1.** As used in this act:
- 7 (a) "Auxiliary container" means a bag, cup, bottle or
- other packaging, whether reusable or single-use, that meets both 8
- of the following requirements: 9
- 10 (i) Is made of cloth, paper, plastic, cardboard,
- 11 corrugated material, aluminum, glass, postconsumer recycled
- 12 material, or similar material or substrates, including coated,
- laminated or multilayer substrates; and 13
- 14 (ii) Is designed for transporting, consuming or
- protecting merchandise, food or beverages from or at a food 15
- 16 service, including manufacturing, distribution or further
- 17 processing, retail facility.

- 18 (b) "Local unit of government" means a county,
- 19 municipality, local taxing entity or any local political
- 20 subdivision thereof.
- 21 SECTION 2. Subject to Section 3 of this act, a local unit
- 22 of government shall not adopt or enforce an ordinance that does
- 23 any of the following:
- 24 (a) Regulates the use, disposition or sale of auxiliary
- 25 containers.
- 26 (b) Prohibits or restricts auxiliary containers.
- 27 (c) Imposes a fee, charge or tax on auxiliary
- 28 containers, or additional sales tax to consumers.
- 29 **SECTION 3.** (1) Section 2 of this act shall not be construed
- 30 to prohibit or restrict any of the following:
- 31 (a) A curbside recycling program.
- 32 (b) A designated residential or commercial recycling
- 33 location.
- 34 (c) A commercial recycling program.
- 35 (2) Section 2 of this act does not apply to any of the
- 36 following;
- 37 (a) An ordinance that prohibits littering as described
- 38 in Sections 97-15-29, 97-15-30 and 97-15-31.
- 39 (b) The use of auxiliary containers on property owned
- 40 by a local unit of government.
- 41 **SECTION 4.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 42 and after July 1, 2018.
