## COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 2588

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 67-1-101, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 2 TO AUTHORIZE ANY MUNICIPALITY THAT HAS VOTED IN FAVOR OF COMING 3 OUT FROM UNDER THE DRY LAW OR THAT IS IN A COUNTY THAT HAS VOTED 4 IN FAVOR OF COMING OUT FROM UNDER THE DRY LAW, AND ANY COUNTY THAT 5 HAS VOTED IN FAVOR OF COMING OUT FROM UNDER THE DRY LAW, TO 6 ESTABLISH LEISURE AND RECREATION DISTRICTS UNDER THE LOCAL OPTION 7 ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONTROL LAW; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. Section 67-1-101, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 9 10 amended as follows: 11 67-1-101. (1) For the purposes of this section, the following words shall have the following meanings ascribed in this 12 13 section, unless the context clearly otherwise requires: 14 (a) "Municipality" means any incorporated city, town or 15 village \* \* \* that has voted in favor of coming out from under the 16 dry law or is in a county that has voted in favor of coming out 17 from under the dry law. (b) "Leisure and recreation district" means an area 18 officially designated by ordinance or resolution of the governing 19

20 authorities of a municipality or county as a leisure and 21 recreation district.

(c) "County" means any county that has voted in favor
of coming out from under the dry law.

24 (2)(a) \* \* \* Subject to the provisions of this section, 25 the governing authorities of a municipality, by ordinance, may 26 establish one or more leisure and recreation districts within the 27 corporate boundaries of the municipality and designate the 28 geographic area or areas to be included within a district. The 29 governing authorities of a municipality, by ordinance, may modify the boundaries of a leisure and recreation district. In addition, 30 the boundaries of a leisure and recreation district may extend 31 32 from within the municipality into the unincorporated area of the county in which the municipality is located if the county consents 33 to the extension and has voted in favor of coming out from under 34 35 the dry law.

37 (\*\*\*<u>b</u>) Subject to the provisions of this section, 38 the board of Supervisors of \* \* \* <u>a county</u>, by resolution, may 39 establish one or more leisure and recreation districts within the 40 county that are outside the corporate limits of any municipality 41 in the county and designate the geographic area or areas to be 42 included within the districts.

No. 2588 18/SS01/R937CS PAGE 2 44 ( **\* \* \***<sub>C</sub>) The designation or modification of the 45 geographic area or areas as a leisure and recreation district shall include a detailed description of the area or areas within 46 the district, boundaries of the district and a georeferenced map 47 48 of the district. In addition to any other matters addressed in an 49 ordinance or resolution establishing or modifying a leisure and recreation district, a municipality or county, as the case may be, 50 51 must describe the manner in which the municipality or county, as 52 the case may be, will provide for adequate law enforcement and 53 other public safety measures and services within the district. 54 Following the establishment and/or modification of a leisure and 55 recreation district, the municipality or county, as the case may 56 be, shall provide the Department of Revenue with (i) a copy of any 57 ordinance or resolution relating to the establishment or modification of the district, (ii) verification from the municipal 58 59 police department and/or applicable sheriff's department 60 indicating how such department will provide adequate law enforcement and other public safety measures and services within 61 62 the district, and (iii) a list of persons or other entities that 63 hold permits issued under Section 67-1-51(c), (e), (f), (g), (l), 64 (n) or (o) and are located and/or doing business under such 65 permits in the district at the time the district is established. SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 66

67 and after July 1, 2018.
