SENATE BILL NO. 2629

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 63-3-103, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REVISE THE DEFINITION OF THE TERM "AUTOCYCLE" AS USED IN THE UNIFORM HIGHWAY TRAFFIC REGULATION LAW; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 **SECTION 1.** Section 63-3-103, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 6 amended as follows:
- 7 63-3-103. (a) "Vehicle" means every device in, upon or by
- 8 which any person or property is or may be transported or drawn
- 9 upon a highway, except devices used exclusively upon stationary
- 10 rails or tracks.
- 11 (b) "Motor vehicle" means every vehicle which is
- 12 self-propelled and every vehicle which is propelled by electric
- 13 power obtained from overhead trolley wires, but not operated upon
- 14 rails. The term "motor vehicle" shall not include electric
- 15 personal assistive mobility devices.
- 16 (c) "Motorcycle" means every motor vehicle having a saddle
- 17 for the use of the rider and designed to travel on not more than
- 18 three (3) wheels in contact with the ground but excluding a

- 19 tractor. The term "motorcycle" includes motor scooters as defined
- 20 in paragraph (j) of this subsection.
- 21 (d) "Authorized emergency vehicle" means every vehicle of
- 22 the fire department (fire patrol), every police vehicle, every 911
- 23 Emergency Communications District vehicle, every such ambulance
- 24 and special use EMS vehicle as defined in Section 41-59-3, every
- 25 Mississippi Emergency Management Agency vehicle as is designated
- or authorized by the Executive Director of MEMA and every
- 27 emergency vehicle of municipal departments or public service
- 28 corporations as is designated or authorized by the commission or
- 29 the chief of police of an incorporated city.
- 30 (e) "School bus" means every motor vehicle operated for the
- 31 transportation of children to or from any school, provided same is
- 32 plainly marked "School Bus" on the front and rear thereof and
- 33 meets the requirements of the State Board of Education as
- 34 authorized under Section 37-41-1.
- 35 (f) "Recreational vehicle" means a vehicular type unit
- 36 primarily designed as temporary living quarters for recreational,
- 37 camping or travel use, which either has its own motive power or is
- 38 mounted on or drawn by another vehicle and includes travel
- 39 trailers, fifth-wheel trailers, camping trailers, truck campers
- 40 and motor homes.
- 41 (q) "Motor home" means a motor vehicle that is designed and
- 42 constructed primarily to provide temporary living quarters for
- 43 recreational, camping or travel use.

44	(h) "Electric assistive mobility device" means a
45	self-balancing two-tandem wheeled device, designed to transport
46	only one (1) person, with an electric propulsion system that
47	limits the maximum speed of the device to fifteen (15) miles per

- 48 hour.
- (i) "Autocycle" means a $\underline{\text{three-wheel}}$ motorcycle with * * * $\underline{\text{a}}$
- 50 steering wheel, nonstraddle seating, rollover protection and seat
- 51 belts.
- 52 (j) "Motor scooter" means a two-wheeled vehicle that has a
- 53 seat for the operator, one (1) wheel that is ten (10) inches or
- 54 more in diameter, a step-through chassis, a motor with a rating of
- 55 two and seven-tenths (2.7) brake horsepower or less if the motor
- is an internal combustion engine, an engine of 50cc or less and
- 57 otherwise meets all safety requirements of motorcycles.
- 58 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 59 and after July 1, 2018.
