- AN ACT TO CREATE NEW SECTION 97-3-28, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROVIDE THAT AN OVERDOSE DEATH ATTRIBUTABLE TO THE
- 3 UNLAWFUL DISTRIBUTION OF CERTAIN CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES WILL
- 4 CONSTITUTE MANSLAUGHTER; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 **SECTION 1.** The following shall be codified as Section
- 7 97-3-28, Mississippi Code of 1972:
- 8 97-3-28. The death of a human being caused by an overdose of
- 9 a controlled substance listed either in Schedule I, Section
- 41-29-113, or Schedule II, Section 41-29-115, when the controlled
- 11 substance was unlawfully distributed to the deceased by a person
- 12 eighteen (18) years of age or older, shall be manslaughter if the
- 13 controlled substance unlawfully distributed to the deceased is
- 14 proven to be the proximate cause of the death.
- 15 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 16 and after July 1, 2018.
