- AN ACT TO CREATE SECTION 87-7-9, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO SPECIFY THE MAXIMUM RETAINAGE ALLOWED FOR PRIVATE CONTRACTS TO

- 8 87-7-9. (1) As used in this section, the following words
- 9 shall have the meanings ascribed to them as follows:
- 10 (a) "Contract" means a written or oral agreement
- 11 between the owner and contractor relative to the design,
- 12 construction, alteration, repair, or maintenance of a building,
- 13 structure, highway, appurtenance, appliance or other improvements
- 14 to real property.
- 15 (b) "Contractor" means any person contracting or
- 16 undertaking with an owner to do any erection, building,
- 17 construction, reconstruction, repair, maintenance or related work
- 18 on private projects.

- 19 "Owner" means any individual, corporation,
- 20 nonprofit corporation, partnership, limited partnership, limited
- liability company or other business entity that is the owner of 21
- 22 record or lessee of real property subject to the applicable terms
- 23 of the contract.
- 24 (2)(a) In any contract for the construction, repair,
- alteration or demolition of any building, structure or facility 25
- 26 situated within the boundaries of the State of Mississippi, that
- 27 provides for progress payments in installments based upon an
- 28 estimated percentage of completion with a percentage of the
- 29 contract proceeds to be retained by one (1) of the parties to that
- 30 contract, a third party to that contract or contractor, pending
- 31 completion of the contract, such retainage shall be no more than
- 32 five percent (5%), and the amount retained by the contractor from
- 33 each payment due any subcontractor shall not exceed five percent
- 34 (5%).
- 35 On any contract, of which the total amount is Two (b)
- Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000.00) or greater, or on any 36
- 37 contract with a subcontractor, regardless of amount, five percent
- 38 (5%) shall be retained.

- 40 contract for the construction, repair, alteration or demolition of
