## SENATE BILL NO. 2828

AN ACT TO REPEAL SECTIONS 11-62-1, 11-62-3, 11-62-5, 11-62-7, 11-62-9, 11-62-11, 11-62-13, 11-62-15, 11-62-17 AND 11-62-19, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, WHICH ARE THE "PROTECTING FREEDOM OF CONSCIENCE FROM GOVERNMENT DISCRIMINATION ACT" AND WHICH DEFINE ECERTAIN PROTECTED BELIEFS AND GOVERNMENTAL DISCRIMINATORY ACTION; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. Sections 11-62-1, 11-62-3, 11-62-5, 11-62-7, 11-62-9, 11-62-11, 11-62-13, 11-62-15, 11-62-17 and 11-62-19, Mississippi Code of 1972, which are the "Protecting Freedom of Conscience from Government Discrimination Act" and which define certain protected beliefs and governmental discriminatory action, are hereby repealed.

## 14 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 15 and after its passage.
