- 8 99-5-13. When it shall appear to the \star \star court that
- 9 originally set bail or the court before which any person charged
- 10 with a criminal offense has given bail to appear that the bail set
- 11 is insufficient or excessive in any respect, * * * then either
- 12 court may (i) after a hearing, order the issuance of a revised
- 13 mittimus reducing the previously set bail; or (ii) order the
- 14 issuance of process for the arrest of such person, and may, after
- 15 a hearing, require him to give bail as may be ordered, and, in
- 16 default thereof, may commit him to jail as in other cases.
- 17 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 18 and after its passage.
