SENATE BILL NO. 2920

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 49-7-58.1, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 2 TO PROVIDE THAT FROM AND AFTER JULY 1, 2018, ENCLOSURES INTENDED
- TO CONTAIN WHITE-TAILED DEER AND PREVENT THE FREE EGRESS OF
- WHITE-TAILED DEER FROM THE ENCLOSED AREA SHALL NOT BE CONSTRUCTED,
- 5 EXISTING ENCLOSURES SHALL NOT BE EXPANDED AND ANY BREEDING
- 6 FACILITIES AT EXISTING ENCLOSURES SHALL NOT BE EXPANDED; AND FOR 7 RELATED PURPOSES.
- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 9 **SECTION 1.** Section 49-7-58.1, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 10 amended as follows:
- 11 49-7-58.1. (1) The owner of any enclosure containing
- 12 white-tailed deer that prevents the free egress of white-tailed
- 13 deer from the enclosed area shall notify and register with the
- Department of Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks. The person shall 14
- give his name, the location of the enclosure, the acreage within 15
- 16 the enclosure, and whether any deer have been imported into the
- state and placed in the enclosure, and any other information 17
- required by the Commissioner on Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks. 18
- 19 (2) Persons who constructed an enclosure prior to July 1,
- 2003, shall have until January 1, 2004, to notify and provide the 20

- 21 information required under this section. The person shall use
- 22 acceptable hunting and wildlife management practices as may be
- 23 determined by the department.
- 24 (3) The owner of such an enclosure shall comply with any
- 25 testing of white-tailed deer harvested within the enclosure as may
- 26 be required by the department. If chronic wasting disease is
- 27 diagnosed within five (5) miles of the enclosure, the owner of
- 28 such enclosure shall allow department personnel to enter the
- 29 enclosure to utilize lethal collection methods to obtain tissue
- 30 samples for testing. If chronic wasting disease is diagnosed
- 31 within the enclosure, the owner shall allow department personnel
- 32 to enter the enclosure and depopulate the white-tailed deer within
- 33 the enclosure.
- 34 (4) From and after July 1, 2018:
- 35 (a) New enclosures intended to contain white-tailed
- 36 deer and prevent the free egress of white-tailed deer from the
- 37 enclosed area shall not be constructed;
- 38 (b) Existing enclosures that contain white-tailed deer
- 39 and prevent the free egress of white-tailed deer from the enclosed
- 40 area shall not be expanded and any breeding facilities at existing
- 41 enclosures shall not be expanded.
- 42 (* * *5) A violation of this section is a Class I violation
- 43 and is punishable as provided in Section 49-7-141.
- 44 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 45 and after July 1, 2018.

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ST: Wildlife; enact a moratorium on construction and expansion of white-tailed deer enclosures.
