4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
5	SECTION 1. The following sum of money, or so much thereof as
6	may be necessary, is hereby appropriated, out of any money in the
7	Special Fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the
8	Mississippi Egg Marketing Board, to defray the expenses of said
9	board for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2018, and ending
10	June 30, 2019\$ 74,805.00.
11	SECTION 2. It is the intention of the Legislature that
12	whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the
13	purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things
14	stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,
15	quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind
16	shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to
17	the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are
18	made without competitive bids.

19	SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
20	funds herein appropriated shall be expended in compliance with
21	Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, that no state agency
22	shall incur obligations or indebtedness in excess of their
23	appropriation and that the responsible officers, either personally
24	or upon their official bonds, shall be held responsible for
25	actions contrary to this provision.
26	SECTION 4. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
27	the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
28	credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
29	warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
30	Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
31	proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.
32	SECTION 5 This act shall take effect and be in force from

and after July 1, 2018.
