6	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be		
7	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State		
8	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for expenses of the		
9	Executive Department, being the Governor's office and staff, and		
10	for expenses incidental to the proper operation of the Governor's		
11	Mansion and residence of the Governor for the fiscal year		
12	beginning July 1, 2018, and ending June 30, 2019		
13	\$ 2,369,391.00.		
14	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be		
15	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State		
16	Treasury to the credit of the Governor's office for the purpose of		
17	defraying the expenses incurred by the Executive Department, being		
18	the Governor's office and staff, for the fiscal year beginning		
19	July 1, 2018, and ending June 30, 2019\$ 603,039.00.		
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20	SECTION 3. Of	the funds appropriated under the provisions of	
21	Section 1 and Secti	on 2, the following positions are authorized:

27	Any escalations shall be made in accordance with the terms,

33	SECTION 4. It	is the intention of the Legislature that

36	stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,		
37	quality and service	, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind	
38	shall be given pref	erence. A similar preference shall be given to	
39	the Mississippi Ind	ustries for the Blind whenever purchases are

41	SECTION 5. It	is the intention of the Legislature that the	
42	Executive Departmen	t shall maintain complete accounting and	
43	personnel records r	elated to the expenditure of all funds

- 55 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 56 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

- 58 and after July 1, 2018.
