## SENATE BILL NO. 2990 (As Sent to Governor)

1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING 2 THE EXPENSES OF THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF AUDIT FOR FISCAL YEAR 3 2019. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4 5 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 6 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any funds in the State 7 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of paying salaries and defraying the expenses of the State Department of 8 9 Audit in making the audits and investigations of public offices of the state and counties as provided by Section 7-7-201 et seq., 10 11 Mississippi Code of 1972, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2018, and ending June 30, 2019.....\$ 8,544,257.00. 12 13 SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 14 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any special funds in the 15 State Treasury to the credit of the State Department of Audit's 16 special fund account for the purpose of paying salaries and defraying the expenses of the State Department of Audit in making 17 18 the audits and investigations of public offices of the state and

19	counties as provided by Section 7-7-201 et seq., Mississippi Code
20	of 1972, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2018, and ending
21	June 30, 2019\$ 2,199,085.00.
22	SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
23	this act, the following positions are authorized:

25	Permanent: Full Time
26	Part Time 3

29	With the funds herein appropriated, it shall be the agency's
30	responsibility to make certain that funds required to be
31	appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2020 do not
32	exceed Fiscal Year 2019 funds appropriated for that purpose,
33	unless programs or positions are added to the agency's Fiscal Year
34	2019 budget by the Mississippi Legislature. Based on data
35	provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel
36	Board shall determine and publish the projected annual cost to
37	fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with the
38	provisions of this act. It shall be the responsibility of the
39	agency head to ensure that no single personnel action increases
40	this projected annual cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2019
41	appropriations for "Personal Services" when annualized, with the
42	exception of escalated funds and the award of benchmarks. If, at
43	the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal

- 44 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency
- 45 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this
- 46 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2019 "Personal Services"
- 47 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which
- 48 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation
- 49 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until
- 50 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.
- Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
- 52 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or
- 53 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State
- 54 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written
- 55 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The
- 56 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
- 57 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions
- 58 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
- 59 appropriated level.
- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 61 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 62 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 63 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- None of the funds herein appropriated shall be used in
- 65 violation of Internal Revenue Service's Publication 15-A relating
- 66 to the reporting of income paid to contract employees, as
- 67 interpreted by the Office of the State Auditor.

68	SECTION 4. In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance
69	Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the intent of
70	the Legislature that the funds provided herein shall be utilized
71	in the most efficient and effective manner possible to achieve the
72	intended mission of this agency. Based on the funding authorized,
73	this agency shall make every effort to attain the targeted

- 119 **SECTION 6.** Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, it is the
- 120 intention of the Legislature that Thirty Thousand Dollars
- 121 (\$30,000.00) is provided for the purpose of paying fees for a CPA
- 122 Review Course for the Office of the State Auditor employees to be
- 123 reimbursed over a 12-month period by the employee taking the
- 124 course.
- 125 **SECTION 7.** Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
- 126 Section 2, funds may be expended to defray the costs of clothing
- 127 for sworn nonuniform law enforcement officers in an amount not to
- 128 exceed Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) annually per officer.
- 129 **SECTION 8.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 130 State Auditor is hereby authorized to escalate, budget and expend
- 131 funds from any source made available to comply with the Single
- 132 Audit Act of 1984, in an amount not to exceed One Million Eight
- 133 Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,800,000.00), for the purpose of
- 134 employing staff, paying related expenses, or to engage private
- 135 accountants, as necessary, to comply with the provisions of the
- 136 act, in accordance with rules and regulations of the Department of
- 137 Finance and Administration in a manner consistent with the
- 138 escalation of federal funds.
- 139 **SECTION 9.** Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, One
- 140 Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) is provided to defray expenses
- 141 incurred by the Office of the State Auditor pursuant to the rules

143	Equitable Sharing Program. These funds may only be used for law
144	enforcement purposes by the Office of the State Auditor.
145	SECTION 10. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
146	State Department of Audit shall maintain complete accounting and
147	personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds
148	appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the
149	same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year
150	2018. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the
151	agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2020 shall be submitted to
152	the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of
153	detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided
154	during the Fiscal Year 2019 budget request process.
155	SECTION 11. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
156	the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
157	credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
158	warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
159	Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
160	proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.
161	SECTION 12. This act shall take effect and be in force from
162	and after July 1, 2018.
