SENATE BILL NO. 3026

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE GOVERNING AUTHORITIES OF THE CITY OF
BAY ST. LOUIS, MISSISSIPPI, TO ALLOW THE OPERATION OF LOW-SPEED
VEHICLES AND GOLF CARTS ON CERTAIN PUBLIC ROADS AND STREETS WITHIN
THE CITY OF BAY ST. LOUIS; TO REQUIRE INDIVIDUALS OPERATING A
LOW-SPEED VEHICLE OR GOLF CART TO HAVE A VALID DRIVERS LICENSE AND
PROOF OF INSURANCE; TO REQUIRE LOW-SPEED VEHICLES OR GOLF CARTS TO
BE REGISTERED WITH THE CITY; TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY TO CHARGE A
REGISTRATION FEE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

- 9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 10 **SECTION 1.** As used in this act, unless a different meaning
- 11 clearly appears in the context, the following terms shall have the
- 12 following meanings:
- 13 (a) "City" means the City of Bay St. Louis,
- 14 Mississippi.
- 15 (b) "Governing authorities" mean the Mayor and City
- 16 Council of the City of Bay St. Louis, Mississippi.
- 17 (c) "Golf cart" means a motor vehicle that is
- 18 designated and manufactured for operation on a golf course for
- 19 sporting or recreational purposes and that is not capable of
- 20 exceeding speeds of twenty (20) miles per hour and is equipped

- 21 with a parking brake, headlamps, tail lamps, seat belts and turn
- 22 signals.
- 23 "Low-speed vehicle" means any four-wheeled electric
- or gasoline-powered vehicle that has a top speed greater than 24
- 25 twenty (20) miles per hour but less than twenty-five (25) miles
- 26 per hour and is equipped with a parking brake, headlamps, tail
- 27 lamps, seat belts and front and rear turn signals.
- 28 SECTION 2. (1)The governing authorities may, in their
- 29 discretion, by ordinance, authorize the operation of low-speed
- vehicles or golf carts only on public roads and streets with a 30
- speed limit of twenty-five (25) miles per hour or less in the City 31
- of Bay St. Louis, Mississippi. The authorization must be embodied 32
- 33 in an ordinance and recorded on the minutes of the City Council.
- The authorization may be accompanied by conditions not 34
- inconsistent with this act and may be revoked, in whole or in 35
- 36 part, by the governing authorities at any time.
- 37 Any person operating a low-speed vehicle or golf cart on
- the public roads and streets in the city under this act must have 38
- 39 in his or her possession a valid driver's license from this state
- 40 or another state and proof of insurance, and follow the applicable
- 41 requirements of Section 63-15-1 et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972.
- 42 (1) Every low-speed vehicle and golf cart SECTION 3.
- operated as authorized under this act on a public road or street 43
- shall be required to register the vehicle with the city. 44
- owner of the low-speed vehicle or golf cart shall be issued a 45

- 46 registration decal by the city that must be displayed as
- 47 determined by the city. The registration shall remain valid for
- 48 as long as the registering owner owns the low-speed vehicle or
- 49 golf cart. The operator shall be required to have proof of
- 50 insurance and a valid driver's license in his or her possession at
- 51 all times while operating the low-speed vehicle or golf cart on
- 52 public roads and streets of the state.
- 53 (2) The city may, by ordinance, establish a registration fee
- 54 for low-speed vehicles and golf carts. The registration fee shall
- 55 be retained by the municipal clerk and deposited into the
- 56 municipal general fund.
- 57 **SECTION 4.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 58 and after its passage.
