SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 504

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND SALUTING THE 2 SIMMONS-HOLLANDALE HIGH SCHOOL "BLUE DEVILS" FOOTBALL TEAM AND 3 COACH WADE TACKETT FOR THEIR THIRD STRAIGHT CLASS 1A STATE TITLE AND THEIR 40TH STRAIGHT VICTORY. 5 WHEREAS, undefeated Nanih Waiya and undefeated Simmons-Hollandale were on a collision course since September 6 7 2017, and the only debate left is which is the unstoppable force and which is the immovable object. On December 1, 2017, the two 8 9 teams met in the 1A State Championship at Vaught-Hemingway Stadium 10 in Oxford. Simmons (14-0) was the two-time defending champ who came into this year's title game having won 39 straight; and 11 12 WHEREAS, first-year Head Coach Wade Tackett picked up right where his predecessor Tavares Johnson left off, and the "Blue 13 14 Devil" have not lost a game since November 21, 2014; and WHEREAS, until the title game, Simmons had not trailed in a 15 game all season, and never in the fourth quarter. The "Blue 16 17 Devils" were down six points with just over two minutes left in the 1A State Championship Game against Nanih Waiya.
