SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 531

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION TO CREATE A STUDY COMMITTEE TO STUDY
THE TAX SYSTEM OF THIS STATE TO STUDY ALL TAX EXEMPTIONS AND
DETERMINE WHICH ONES CAN BE ELIMINATED TO GENERATE SUFFICIENT
FUNDS TO PROVIDE INFRASTRUCTURE AND MAINTENANCE AS RECOMMENDED BY
MOOT ON AN ANNUAL BASIS AND TO MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS THEREON TO THE
LEGISLATURE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

- 7 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MISSISSIPPI STATE
- 8 SENATE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN, That:
- 9 (1) There is hereby created a study committee on the tax
- 10 system of Mississippi to study all tax exemptions and determine
- 11 which ones can be eliminated to general sufficient funds to
- 12 provide infrastructure and maintenance as recommended by the
- 13 Mississippi Department of Transportation on an annual basis. The
- 14 committee shall make a report of its findings and recommendations
- 15 to the Legislature during the 2019 Regular Legislative Session,
- 16 including any recommended legislation.
- 17 (2) The committee shall be composed of the following
- 18 members:
- 19 (a) The President Pro Tempore of the Mississippi
- 20 Senate;

21 (b)	The	Speaker	Pro	Tempore	of	the	Mississippi	House	of
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- 22 Representatives;
- 23 (c) The Chairman of the Senate Appropriations
- 24 Committee;
- 25 (d) The Chairman of the House Appropriations Committee;
- 26 (e) The Chairman of the Senate Finance Committee;
- 27 (f) The Chairman of the House Ways and Means Committee;
- 28 (g) The State Treasurer, or his designee;
- 29 (h) The Executive Director of the Department of Finance
- 30 and Administration;
- 31 (i) The Executive Director of the Mississippi
- 32 Department of Transportation;
- 33 (j) The Executive Director of the Mississippi
- 34 Department of Revenue;
- 35 (k) One (1) member designated by the President of The
- 36 Mississippi Bar from the Taxation Section of The Mississippi Bar;
- 37 (1) One (1) member designated by the Mississippi
- 38 Supervisors Association;
- 39 (m) One (1) member designated by the Mississippi
- 40 Municipal Association; and
- 41 (n) Three (3) representatives of the general public:
- 42 one (1) designated by the Governor, one (1) by the Lieutenant
- 43 Governor and one (1) by the Speaker of the House of
- 44 Representatives.

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- 45 Appointments shall be made within thirty (30) days after the 46 adoption of this resolution by the Legislature, and, within fifteen (15) days thereafter on a day to be designated jointly by 47 the Lieutenant Governor and the Speaker of the House, the 48 49 committee shall meet and organize by selecting from its membership 50 a chairman and a vice chairman. The vice chairman shall also serve as secretary and shall be responsible for keeping all 51 52 records of the committee. A majority of the members of the 53 committee shall constitute a quorum. In the selection of its 54 officers and the adoption of rules, resolutions and reports, an 55 affirmative vote of a majority of the committee shall be required. 56 All members shall be notified in writing of all meetings, such 57 notices to be mailed at least five (5) days prior to the date on
- 59 The committee shall study and make recommendations with 60 respect to the imposition of state taxes and the granting of tax 61 exemptions in all areas of taxation, including, but not limited to, sales taxes, income taxes, privilege taxes, fuel taxes, 62 63 diversions of taxes and the relationship between state and local 64 taxes.
- 65 (4)Members of the committee who are not legislators, state officials or state employees shall be compensated at the per diem 66 rate authorized by Section 25-3-69, Mississippi Code of 1972, and 67 68 shall be reimbursed in accordance with Section 25-3-41,
- Mississippi Code of 1972, for mileage and actual expenses incurred 69

which a meeting is to be held.

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- 70 in the performance of their duties. Legislative members of the
- 71 committee shall be paid from the contingent expense funds of their
- 72 respective houses in the same manner as provided for committee
- 73 meetings when the Legislature is not in session; however, no per
- 74 diem or expense for attending meetings of the committee will be
- 75 paid while the Legislature is in session. No committee member may
- 76 incur per diem, travel or other expenses unless previously
- 77 authorized by vote, at a meeting of the committee, which action
- 78 shall be recorded in the official minutes of the meeting.
- 79 Nonlegislative members shall be paid from any funds made available
- 80 to the committee for that purpose.
- 81 (5) The committee shall utilize clerical and legal staff
- 82 already employed by the Legislature and any other staff assistance
- 83 made available to it. To effectuate the purpose of this
- 84 resolution, any department, division, board, bureau, commission or
- 85 agency of the state or of any political subdivision thereof shall,
- 86 at the request of the chairman of the committee, provide to the
- 87 committee such facilities, assistance and data as will enable the
- 88 committee properly to carry out its task.
- 89 (6) Upon presentation of its report to the 2019 Regular
- 90 Legislative Session, the committee shall be dissolved.
