120	bills" shall include only those bills whose primary purpose is to
121	increase or decrease taxes or to authorize the issuance of bonds
122	or the borrowing of money. Bills which are primarily for
123	regulatory purposes which have revenue provisions included shall
124	not be considered as revenue bills for deadline purposes. The
125	deletion from a bill of the features which made it a revenue bill
126	shall render the bill a general bill for deadline purposes.
127	**Conference reports on all bills must be filed with the
128	Secretary/Clerk no later than the time of adjournment on the day
129	prior to being called up and considered. Appropriation bills
130	which actually appropriate money and are recommitted for further
131	conference are excluded from the requirement that the subsequent
132	conference report be filed and lay on table one (1) day before
133	being considered; however, original action must be taken on all
134	appropriation conference reports by 2:00 p.m. on the 84th/105th
135	day and subsequent reports must be filed no later than 6:00 p.m.
136	***Requests for general bills and constitutional amendments
137	to be drafted must be made no later than $8:00 \text{ p.m.}$ on the $9\text{th}/30\text{th}$
138	day. The Rules Committee of the House or Senate, as the case may
139	be, may authorize any member of its respective house to make
140	requests, for one or more general bills or constitutional
141	amendments to be drafted, after the expiration of the deadline for
142	making such drafting requests but before the deadline for
143	introduction of bills and constitutional amendments, upon a
144	determination by the Rules Committee that such drafting requests

145	are in response to conditions of an emergency nature arising
146	subsequent to the deadline for making requests for general bills
147	and constitutional amendments to be drafted.
148	****The request for drafting and the introduction and
149	consideration of general bills other than those considered
150	revenue bills shall be limited to regular legislative sessions
151	occurring in odd-numbered years, and a general bill other than a
152	general bill considered a revenue bill may not be requested,
153	introduced or considered during a regular legislative session
154	occurring in an even-numbered year. For purposes of this
155	paragraph, a general bill modifying, adding, deleting or repealing
156	language or a repealer on language which provides for the levying
157	of taxes, borrowing of money, issuing bonds, notes or other
158	evidence of debt, providing for fees or imposing the issuance of a
159	license, of whatever kind by the state or any political
160	subdivision of the state, or the exemption of property from state
161	taxes or taxes of any subdivision of the state, is considered a
162	revenue bill, and no revenue bill, conference committee report on
163	a revenue bill, or concurrence in amendments adopted by the other
164	house may be passed or adopted by either the Senate or the House
165	of Representatives except by a vote of at least three-fifths (3/5)
166	of the members of the Senate and House, respectively, present and
167	voting.

168	+Committee reports and conference reports that are subject to
169	being filed on these deadlines must be filed with the
170	Secretary/Clerk no later than 8:00 p.m.
171	Whenever the word "day" appears in this rule, it shall mean
172	calendar day.
173	The above schedule shall not be deviated from except by the
174	passage of a concurrent resolution adopted by a vote of two-thirds
175	(2/3) of the membership of the House and Senate present and
176	voting.
