- WHEREAS, Nanih Waiya, which recorded a 669 score, and Tupelo 8
- 9 Christian Preparatory School at 670, were tied at 338 going into
- 10 the chilly, breezy final round. Tournament host TCPS was the

- WHEREAS, Jacob Kight "just made a fantastic putt," TCPS Coach 12
- Grant Smallwood said. "We really knew it was going to be close. 13
- 14 We didn't know how much up or down. It came down to that putt."

- 16 consecutive season, recorded a 36-hole total of one-over-par

- 17 74-71 -145. Kight said, "Winning as a team was more satisfying
- 18 than winning my individual title. Just to celebrate as a team,
