SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 586

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING KEN
HALL BARNETT ON BEING SELECTED AS THE 2017 STATE GAMES OF
MISSISSIPPI AT&T MALE ATHLETE OF THE YEAR.

4 WHEREAS, based on the national program, the State Games of Mississippi established the annual "Athlete of the Year" Award to 5 6 recognize Mississippi's amateur athletes. Coaches, officials, 7 athletes, volunteers, and spectators nominated one male and one female athlete from each of the 37 sports for the award. "I played tennis for a long time," he said, "and now really enjoy Pickleball." Ken Hall has been in the investment industry for 35 years, and is married to Cherri Barnett, a longtime Teacher and Director of Ballet Mississippi; and

From 28 these 37 athletes, only three are chosen to receive the honor of 29 "Athlete of the Year."
