A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING FEBRUARY 20, 2018, AS HIGHER EDUCATION APPRECIATION DAY, WORKING FOR ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE (HEADWAE), AND SETTING THAT DAY APART AS A SPECIAL DAY TO CONGRATULATE AND EXPRESS APPRECIATION TO REPRESENTATIVES OF THE FACULTY AND STUDENTS OF MISSISSIPPI'S PUBLIC AND PRIVATE UNIVERSITIES, COLLEGES AND COMMUNITY COLLEGES FOR THEIR OUTSTANDING INSTRUCTIONAL GUIDANCE AND ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE.
