SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 606

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING THE GULFPORT HIGH SCHOOL "ADMIRALS" BOYS SOCCER TEAM AND HEAD COACH HENRIK MADSEN FOR WINNING THE 2018 MHSAA CLASS 6A STATE CHAMPIONSHIP.

- 5 WHEREAS, 2010 was the last year the Gulfport High School
- 6 "Admirals" claimed the Class 6A Boys State Soccer Championship.
- 7 The third-ranked Admirals ended that Championship drought when
- 8 they defeated top-ranked Madison Central on February 12, 2018, on
- 9 the campus of Brandon High School. Gulfport Head Coach Henrik
- 10 Madsen said, "It's unbelievable to defeat a team like Madison
- 11 Central that has so many State Championships. We were definitely
- 12 playing some real good soccer at the right part of the season.
- 13 This was our goal from the beginning"; and
- 14 WHEREAS, early goals in each half enabled Gulfport to win an
- 15 MHSAA State Championship in boys soccer for only the second time
- 16 with the 2-1 victory. The win was made all the more impressive
- 17 considering Madison Central had the home field advantage. Its
- 18 campus is located less than three miles from Ridgeland High
- 19 School, the site of Saturday night's game. Gulfport had to travel

- 20 173 miles. The game winner came three minutes into the second
- 21 half. Christopher Bruni put a free kick from 40 yards out in
- 22 front of the goal and Lucas Ragula headed it past the Madison
- 23 Central goalie; and
- 24 WHEREAS, the victory could be considered an upset since
- 25 Madison Central was top-ranked in the state according to MaxPreps
- 26 and Gulfport was No. 3. The Admirals did win a previous matchup,
- 27 2-0 at the 1-10/1-20 Classic. The Admirals finished the season
- 28 with an 11-game winning streak, during which they allowed only two
- 29 goals; and
