SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 638

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING THE LEGACY OF LEADERSHIP 2 AND DEDICATION OF GARY J. HERRING, HEAD OF SCHOOL OF FIRST 3 PRESBYTERIAN DAY SCHOOL, ON THE OCCASION OF HIS RETIREMENT. 4 WHEREAS, Gary J. Herring was born in Brandon, Mississippi, on January 24, 1952, to parents who were both educators. Gary 5 graduated from the University of Mississippi in 1973, and moved to 6 7 Montgomery, Alabama, where he earned his Master's Degree in 8 Business Administration from Auburn University in 1978; and 9 WHEREAS, in 1980, Gary and his wife Jerri and two young daughters moved from Montgomery to Jackson, Mississippi, for Gary 10 11 to assume the position of Business Administrator of First Presbyterian Church. After being approached by the Board of 12 Trustees of First Presbyterian Day School to determine his 13 14 interest in becoming Head of School, Gary enrolled at Mississippi College to receive a Master of Education, Administration and 15 16 Curriculum to prepare for the job; and WHEREAS, Gary became the third Head of School of First 17

18 Presbyterian Day School in 1987 and has faithfully served for more

The kingdom school began in 1965 and continues 20 today with a mission of: planting seeds of Christlikeness in the 21 hearts of children, pursuing excellence in academics, and 22 preparing students for future service in God's kingdom in their 23 homes, churches, and professions; and

24 WHEREAS, during Gary's tenure, the school has seen 25 substantial growth: remodeling of the art room, library, and 26 state-of-the-art science lab; the addition of a K3 and K4 27 preschool program and a new preschool center; the establishment of 28 a dyslexia immersion program; a renovated gymnasium; an updated 29 stage for school productions; and a new playground; and

30 WHEREAS, also during Gary's years of service to First 31 Presbyterian Day School, the school has experienced a reduction in 32 student-teacher ratios; the addition of a day care for children of 33 faculty and staff; numerous curriculum changes; the development of 34 strategic plans; the introduction of modern technology to 35 students, faculty, and classrooms; and the implementation of a schoolwide mission project that has raised thousands of dollars 36 37 for various ministries at home and abroad; and

38 WHEREAS, in 2013, Gary received the Joe F. Shepard Memorial 39 Award from the Mississippi Association of Independent Schools and 40 has overseen the school's membership in the organization. Gary 41 and Jerri have been married for more than 40 years and are the 42 proud parents of Leslie Miley (Ben) and Lindsey Vira (Joey) and
