SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 649

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION DESIGNATING JULY 13, 2018, AS
2 "COLLECTOR CAR APPRECIATION DAY IN MISSISSIPPI" AND RECOGNIZING
3 THAT THE COLLECTION AND RESTORATION OF HISTORIC AND CLASSIC CARS
4 IS AN IMPORTANT PART OF PRESERVING THE TECHNOLOGICAL ACHIEVEMENTS
5 AND CULTURAL HERITAGE OF THE UNITED STATES.

6 WHEREAS, many people in the United States maintain classic
7 automobiles as a pastime and do so with great passion and as a
8 means of individual expression; and

9 WHEREAS, the Legislature recognizes the effect that the
10 100-year history of the automobile has had on the economic
11 progress of the United States and supports wholeheartedly all
12 activities involved in the restoration and exhibition of classic
13 automobiles; and

14 WHEREAS, the collection, restoration and preservation of
15 automobiles is an activity shared across generations and across
16 all segments of society; and

17 WHEREAS, thousands of local car clubs and related businesses
18 have been instrumental in preserving a historic part of the



19 heritage of the United States by encouraging the restoration and
20 exhibition of such vintage works of art; and

21 WHEREAS, automotive restoration provides well-paying,
22 high-skilled jobs for people in all 50 states; and

23 WHEREAS, automobiles have provided the inspiration for music,
24 photography, cinema, fashion, and other artistic pursuits that
25 have become part of the popular culture of the United States:

26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF
27 MISSISSIPPI, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN, That
28 we do hereby designate July 13, 2018, as "Collector Car
29 Appreciation Day in Mississippi," recognizing that the collection
30 and restoration of historic and classic cars is an important part
31 of preserving the technological achievements and cultural heritage
32 of the United States.

33 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That we do hereby encourage the
34 citizens of Mississippi to engage in events and commemorations of
35 Collector Car Appreciation Day in Mississippi that create
36 opportunities for collector car owners to educate young people
37 about the importance of preserving the cultural heritage of the
38 United States through the collection and restoration of collector
39 cars.

40 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That this resolution be disseminated
41 by the Mississippi Development Authority and made available to the
42 Capitol Press Corps.
