SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 652

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING THE
GERMANTOWN HIGH SCHOOL "LADY MAVERICKS" SOCCER TEAM AND COACH
MICHAEL GUIDRY FOR WINNING ITS FIRST 5A STATE CHAMPIONSHIP.

WHEREAS Germantown High School Senior Sam Pennock Waited

4 WHEREAS, Germantown High School Senior Sam Pennock waited

5 years for the opportunity she had on February 17, 2018, at the 5A

Girls' State Championship match. She and the other seven Maverick

7 seniors had lost in the State Championship in both their freshman

8 season. So when the ball bounced to Pennock, giving her a clean

9 look at the goal from 20 yards out on the left wing in double

10 overtime, she knew exactly what to do with it. Pennock's goal had

11 a double effect: It gave the Germantown "Lady Mavericks" a 2-1

12 victory and its first State Title in girls' soccer, and it set off

13 a raucous celebration for the Maverick fans who had sat through

14 four seasons' worth of weather. It was a balmy 70 degrees and

15 sunny when the game started, and 53 degrees and raining sideways

16 in a steady 15 to 20 mile-per-hour winds by halftime, but the fans

17 who stayed saw a great soccer match; and

- 18 WHEREAS, Germantown (17-4-2) struck first with a goal off the
- 19 foot of another senior, Jordan Jones, in the 12th minute. She
- 20 crossed up Long Beach Goldkeeper Alexis Wilson, who did everything
- 21 she could to bring in the diving save. Long Beach (20-1-1) had
- 22 few opportunities to respond until late in the second half. The
- 23 equalizer finally came in the 74th minute when Germantown
- 24 Goldkeeper Georgia Jordan deflected a shot on her goal right to
- 25 Long Beach's Susie Stevison, who booted it into the back of the
- 26 net. The two teams played evenly through the rest of regulation,
- 27 both of the 10-minute overtime periods and through the first seven
- 28 minutes of sudden-death; and
- 29 WHEREAS, "That is what a Championship Game is supposed to
- 30 look like, "Germantown Coach Michael Guidry said. "Just back and
- 31 forth. They had moments where they were in control, and we had
- 32 moments when we thought we were in control. I'm just so happy for
- 33 these girls, because they've worked so hard"; and
