## SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 2

1	A RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING OLE MISS GOLF TEAM
2	STANDOUT BRADEN THORNBERRY FOR WINNING THE UNIVERSITY'S FIRST-EVER
3	2017 MEN'S NCAA INDIVIDUAL GOLF NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP AND FOR
4	REPRESENTING THE UNITED STATES LEADING THE USA TO VICTORY IN THE
5	2017 WALKER CUP MATCHES.

- 6 WHEREAS, Braden Thornberry, a 20-year-old Ole Miss Rebel
- 7 golfer from Olive Branch, was chosen to represent the United
- 8 States in the Walker Cup Matches, which was played at the Los
- 9 Angeles Country Club on September 9-10, 2017. The biennial
- 10 competition featured the best amateur golfers in the United States
- 11 against a team from Britain and Ireland. Braden dominated at the
- 12 Walker Cup, helping Team USA to a 19-7 win over Team Great Britain
- 13 and Ireland, winning both his single matches; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Braden beat Harry Ellis, the 2017 British Amateur
- 15 Champion, despite trailing by two strokes with five holes to play.
- 16 Thornberry won four out of five and halved the other to win 2-up.
- 17 Thornberry made quick work of Paul McBride of Ireland the next
- 18 day, beating him 6-5 in 13 holes. "It was awesome," he said. "I
- 19 think it was a great venue for something like the Walker Cup. The

- 20 course had a good mixture of long and short holes that made it a
- 21 great design"; and
- 22 WHEREAS, this is yet another achievement for Thornberry in
- 23 what is surely the most remarkable year of amateur golf ever
- 24 produced by a Mississippian. Thornberry won five collegiate
- 25 tournaments, including the NCAA Championship. He won the Haskins
- 26 Trophy, golf's equivalent to the Heisman Trophy, as just a
- 27 sophomore. He won the prestigious Sunnehanna Amateur Tournament
- 28 of Champions in Johnstown, Pennsylvania, against an international
- 29 field; and
- 30 WHEREAS, Thornberry is ranked No. 3 in Men's World Amateur
- 31 Golf rankings and defeated the No. 1 ranked player Joaquinn
- 32 Niemann of Chile in the United States Amateur. Perhaps most
- 33 famously, Thornberry finished tied for fourth, two shots out of
- 34 the lead, in the PGA Tour's FedEx St. Jude Classic, and turned
- 35 down more than \$240,000.00 to retain his amateur status; and
- 36 WHEREAS, obviously, Thornberry could turn pro and make a
- 37 fortune playing golf at the level he has played over the past 12
- 38 months. Instead, he will remain and play his junior year at Ole
- 39 Miss where he still believes he can better prepare himself for the
- 40 rigors of the PGA Tour; and
- WHEREAS, on May 29, 2017, Ole Miss Sophomore Standout Braden
- 42 Thornberry shot 71 (1-under) in the final round to erase a
- 43 two-stroke deficit and win the 2017 Men's NCAA Individual Golf

- 44 National Championship at Rich Harvest Farms in Sugar Grove,
- 45 Illinois; and
- 46 WHEREAS, it is the first-ever Individual or Team Golf
- 47 National Championship for the Rebels. Thornberry shot 277
- (66-71-69-71), which was 11-under and four strokes ahead; and
- 49 WHEREAS, "His life will change after this. To win a National
- 50 Title as an individual is huge," said Golf Channel's Billy Ray
- 51 Brown, who won the 1982 Individual Championship while at Houston.
- 52 "He will be on stage each and every week as he continues on in his
- 53 amateur career"; and
- 54 WHEREAS, Thornberry had won four tournaments prior to his
- 55 National Title win. He entered the day two strokes behind. Ole
- 56 Miss, coached by Chris Malloy, finished tied for 22nd in a 30-team
- 57 field and missed the cut by 17 strokes; and
- 58 WHEREAS, "It means a lot to be the Champion," Thornberry
- 59 said. "As far as the team, we knew we were going to have a
- 60 special year when we started off and we weren't surprised at all."
- 61 Thornberry played spectacular golf headed into the 2017 college
- 62 season; and
- 63 WHEREAS, it is with great pride that we recognize this
- 64 special achievement by a university athlete who has brought honor
- 65 to his university, his community and to the State of Mississippi:
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF
- 67 MISSISSIPPI, That we do hereby commend and congratulate Ole Miss
- 68 Sophomore Standout Braden Thornberry for winning the University's

- 69 first-ever 2017 Men's NCAA Individual Golf National Championship
- 70 and for representing the United States leading the USA to victory
- 71 in the 2017 Walker Cup Matches, and extend to Braden and his
- 72 family our best wishes for future success at this level and in his
- 73 professional career.
- 74 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That this resolution be presented to
- 75 Braden Thornberry and Coach Chris Malloy, forwarded to Chancellor
- 76 Jeffrey S. Vitter and the Board of Trustees of State Institutions
- 77 of Higher Learning, and made available to the Capitol Press Corps.
