SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 9

1 A RESOLUTION COMMENDING THE OUTSTANDING LEGACY OF PUBLIC
2 SERVICE OF MILFORD CURRIE AFTER 40 YEARS OF DEDICATED SERVICE TO
3 THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE AND THE MISSISSIPPI DEPARTMENT OF ARCHIVES

11 the exhibits section of the State Historical Museum at the Old
12 Capitol Restoration; and

13 WHEREAS, Currie helped fabricate and install more than 100
14 award-winning exhibits at the Old Capitol; and

15 WHEREAS, Currie refurbished traveling exhibits and
16 transported them to local museums and libraries across the state;

18 WHEREAS, Currie was invaluable for his ready assistance with
19 set-up for special events and programs, and he often escorted
20 scholars and dignitaries; and

21 WHEREAS, Currie also worked in the MDAH Administration
22 Division in the mailroom; and

23 WHEREAS, in this role, Currie became known and beloved in the
24 community as he carried out his duties on behalf of the
25 department; and

26 WHEREAS, over the years, Currie established a special rapport
27 with members of the Legislature, staff, and everyone else at the
28 State Capitol; and

29 WHEREAS, Currie will be greatly missed by his friends and
30 colleagues for his welcoming manner, dedication, and good taste in
31 music; and

32 WHEREAS, we join the Mississippi Department of Archives and
33 History in recognizing a wonderful example for public servants:

34 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF
35 MISSISSIPPI, That we do hereby commend the outstanding legacy of
36 public service of Milford Currie after 40 years of dedicated
