**AMENDMENT NO. _____ TO
SENATE BILL NO. 2001**

2 **AMEND** after line 134 by deleting section 43 in its
3 entirety and inserting the following new section:

4 "**SECTION 43.** (1)Until June 30, 2028, Fifty percent (50%) of the
5 revenues generated by the Mississippi Lottery Law, created
6 pursuant to Sections 1 through 46 of this act and deposited into
7 the Lottery Proceeds Fund under Section 26(2)(a) of this act shall
8 be paid into the State Highway Fund by warrant issued by the State
9 Fiscal Officer upon requisition of the State Transportation
10 Commission as needed to provide funds to repair, renovate and
11 maintain highways and bridges of the state; however, funds paid
12 into the State Highway Fund under this section shall be first used
13 for matching federal funds authorized to the state pursuant to any

14 federal highway infrastructure program implemented after September
15 1, 2018. From and after July 1, 2028, the revenue shall be
16 deposited into the Lottery Proceeds Fund and shall be transferred
17 to the State General Fund."

18 (2)(a)Until June 30, 2028, Fifty percent (50%) of the
19 revenues generated by the Mississippi Lottery Law, created
20 pursuant to Sections 1 through 46 of this act and deposited into
21 the Lottery Proceeds Fund under Section 26(2)(a) of this act shall
22 be paid into the Teacher and Assistant Teacher Supplemental Salary
23 Fund created in paragraph (b) of this subsection and used for the
24 purposes described.

25 (b)A special fund, to be designated as the "Teacher and
26 Assistant Teacher Supplemental Salary Fund", is created within the
27 State Treasury. The fund shall be maintained by the State
28 Treasurer as a separate and special fund, separate and apart from
29 the General Fund of the state. The fund shall consist of monies
30 deposited therein under paragraph (a) of this subsection and
31 monies from any other source designated for deposit into such
32 fund. Monies in the fund shall be expended by the State Board of
33 Education to provide an annual salary supplement in an amount of
34 Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500.00) to each public
35 school teacher who is licensed or authorized to teach in a public
36 school by the State Board of Education, and each public school
37 assistant teacher authorized by the State Board of Education to
38 assist pupils in actual instruction under the supervision of a

39 licensed teacher. Such supplement shall be in addition to any
40 other supplement or salary authorized by law to compensate
41 teachers and assistant teachers. Unexpended amounts remaining in
42 the fund at the end of a fiscal year shall not lapse into the
43 State General Fund, and any interest earned or investment earnings
44 on amounts in the fund shall be deposited to the credit of the
45 fund.
