HOUSE BILL NO. 73

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 63-16-5, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 2 AUTHORIZE LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS TO USE A LICENSE-PLATE READER 3 THAT UTILIZES THE MOTOR VEHICLE INSURANCE VERIFICATION SYSTEM TO 4 ENFORCE MOTOR VEHICLE LIABILITY INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS; AND FOR 5 RELATED PURPOSES. 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 7 SECTION 1. Section 63-16-5, Mississippi Code of 1972, is amended as follows: 8 9 63-16-5. (1) A law enforcement officer or authorized

- 10 employee of a law enforcement agency may, during the course of a
- 11 traffic stop or accident investigation, or when using a
- 12 license-plate reader that utilizes the verification system, access
- 13 the verification system established under Section 63-16-3 to
- 14 verify whether a motor vehicle is covered by a valid motor vehicle
- 15 liability policy in at least the minimum amounts required under
- 16 Section 63-15-3(i).
- 17 (2) The response received from the system supersedes an
- 18 insurance card produced by a motor vehicle operator, and
- 19 notwithstanding the display of an insurance card by the operator,

- 20 the law enforcement officer may issue a complaint and notice to
- 21 appear to the operator for a violation of the Mississippi Motor
- 22 Vehicle Safety-Responsibility Law. A law enforcement officer may
- 23 exercise discretion in issuing a citation during the first sixty
- 24 (60) days after proof of temporary insurance is issued by an
- 25 insurance company, if the verification system shows that the
- 26 insured's policy is expired and the operator provides proof of
- 27 insurance with a new insurance company or a new insurance card.
- 28 (3) Except when using a license-plate reader that utilizes
- 29 the verification system or upon reasonable cause to believe that a
- 30 driver has violated another traffic regulation or that the
- 31 driver's motor vehicle is unsafe or not equipped as required by
- 32 law, a law enforcement officer may not use the verification system
- 33 to stop a driver for operating a motor vehicle in violation of
- 34 this chapter.
- 35 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 36 and after July 1, 2019.
