## HOUSE BILL NO. 98 (As Passed the House)

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 49-15-78, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,
  TO PROHIBIT THE USE OF A HAUL SEINE NET FOR THE TAKING OF <u>FISH</u> IN

- 8 **SECTION 1.** Section 49-15-78, Mississippi Code of 1972, is

- 10 49-15-78. (1) (a) It is unlawful for a person to use a
- 11 gill net, trammel net, entanglement net, or like contrivances for
- 12 the taking of \* \* \* finfish in marine waters within one-half (1/2)
- 13 mile of the shoreline.
- 14 (b) For the purposes of this section, the phrase "like
- 15 contrivances" means any net that is similar in form, function,
- 16 purpose or use to a gill net, trammel net, entanglement net.
- 17 (c) It is unlawful for a person to use a haul seine net
- 18 for the taking of fish in marine waters within one-half (1/2) mile
- 19 of the shoreline of Cat Island.
