HOUSE BILL NO. 142

- AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT FOR THE PURPOSES OF CHAPTER 15, TITLE
- 2 23, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, THERE IS A STRONG REBUTTABLE
- 3 PRESUMPTION THAT THE LOCATION OF PROPERTY THAT A PERSON CLAIMS FOR
- 4 HOMESTEAD EXEMPTION IS THE PERSON'S RESIDENCE.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 **SECTION 1.** For the purposes of Chapter 15, Title 23,
- 7 Mississippi Code of 1972, there is a strong but rebuttable
- 8 presumption that the county, municipality or political subdivision
- 9 in which a person claims any real property for homestead exemption
- 10 in accordance with Section 85-3-21, is also the location of the
- 11 person's residence.
- 12 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 13 and after July 1, 2019.
