HOUSE BILL NO. 156

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 65-7-1, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO CLARIFY COUNTY JURISDICTION OVER ROADS ORIGINALLY CONSTRUCTED AS A STATE HIGHWAY; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 **SECTION 1.** Section 65-7-1, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 6 amended as follows:
- 7 65-7-1. (1) The board of supervisors of each county shall
- 8 have full jurisdiction over all matters relating to the public
- 9 roads of the county, including the establishment, laying out,
- 10 opening, abandonment, altering, changing, working and maintaining
- 11 of such roads, except as otherwise provided by Section 170 of the
- 12 Mississippi Constitution of 1890.
- 13 (2) All roads now laid out and opened or hereafter laid out
- 14 and opened according to law shall be deemed public roads and
- 15 highways and shall be opened and worked at least sixteen (16) feet
- 16 wide, wherever practicable, and in any case not less than twelve
- 17 (12) feet, and any greater width that may be necessary. Ditches

- and borrow pits shall be kept open or connected so as to drain off the water from the road bed, as far as practicable.
- 20 (3) * * * No road, whether originally constructed as a state
- 21 highway or not, shall be included as a part of the county road
- 22 system until and unless the board of supervisors, by appropriate
- 23 action spread on its minutes, has established or accepted such
- 24 road and caused the road to be included in the official record of
- 25 the county road system as provided in Section 65-7-4.
- 26 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 27 and after July 1, 2019.
