The driver or operator of any motor vehicle must 10 decrease speed when approaching and crossing an intersection, when 11 approaching and going around a curve, when approaching a hill 12 crest, when traveling upon any narrow or winding roadway, or when special hazard exists with respect to pedestrians or other 13 traffic. All trucks, or truck-trailer combinations and passenger 14 15 buses shall be required to reduce speed to forty-five (45) miles 16 per hour during inclement weather * * *. 17 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
