(1) If any person shall willfully disturb any session of * * * a school or * * * a school meeting, such person 8 9 shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, shall be punished by a fine of not less than Ten Dollars (\$10.00) nor more 10 11 than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00). 12 (2) A person who, by any means, including social media, threatens to commit a crime of violence or to cause bodily injury 13 14 to a superintendent, principal, teacher, student, staff or any other employee of a school, which threat is intended to terrorize, 15 16 harm, intimidate, disrupt or disturb any session of the school or any school meeting, is guilty of a felony punishable by 17
