## HOUSE BILL NO. 602

- AN ACT TO RESTORE THE RIGHT OF SUFFRAGE TO JAMES VAUGHN OF TUNICA COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 4 **SECTION 1.** The right of suffrage is hereby fully and
- 5 completely restored to James Vaughn of Tunica County, Mississippi,
- 6 who was disqualified as an elector as a result of his conviction
- 7 for grand larceny on March 9, 2001, in Tunica County Circuit Court
- 8 to a term of four (4) years probation, which was revoked for
- 9 violations when he was sentenced on September 14, 2001, in Tunica
- 10 County Circuit Court, and on September 25, 2001, in Tunica County
- 11 Circuit Court for the sell of cocaine and grand larceny to a total
- 12 term of 10 years in the custody of the Mississippi Department of
- 13 Corrections. The Mississippi Department of Corrections discharged
- 14 James Vaughn on December 14, 2011, after he completed earned
- 15 release supervision.
- 16 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 17 and after its passage.
