HOUSE BILL NO. 730

- 1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 27-115-55, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 2 TO CLARIFY THAT A RETAIL LIQUOR STORE SHALL BE ELIGIBLE TO APPLY 3 TO BECOME A LOTTERY RETAILER; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- **SECTION 1.** Section 27-115-55, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 5
- amended as follows: 6
- 7 27-115-55. (1) The Legislature hereby recognizes that to
- conduct a successful lottery, the corporation must develop and 8
- 9 maintain a statewide network of lottery retailers that will serve
- 10 the public convenience and promote the sale of tickets, while
- 11 ensuring the integrity of the lottery operations, games and
- 12 activities.
- To govern the selection of lottery retailers, the board 13
- 14 shall, by administrative rules and regulations, develop a list of
- 15 objective criteria upon which the selection of lottery retailers
- 16 shall be based. In developing these criteria, the board shall
- consider such factors as the applicant's financial responsibility, 17
- 18 location and security of the applicant's place of business or

- 19 activity, integrity, and reputation; however, the board shall not
- 20 consider political affiliation, activities or monetary
- 21 contributions to political organizations or candidates for any
- 22 public office. The criteria shall include, but not be limited to,
- 23 the following:
- 24 (a) The applicant shall be current in payment of all
- 25 taxes, interest and penalties owed to any taxing political
- 26 subdivision where the lottery retailer will sell lottery tickets.
- 27 (b) The applicant shall be current in filing all
- 28 applicable tax returns and in payment of all taxes, interest and
- 29 penalties owed to the State of Mississippi, excluding items under
- 30 formal appeal pursuant to applicable statutes, before a license is
- 31 issued and before each renewal.
- 32 (c) No person shall be selected as a lottery retailer
- 33 for the sale of lottery tickets who:
- 34 (i) Has been convicted of a criminal offense
- 35 related to the security or integrity of the lottery in this or any
- 36 other jurisdiction.
- 37 (ii) Has been convicted of any illegal gambling
- 38 activity, false statements, false swearing or perjury in this or
- 39 any other jurisdiction, or convicted of a felony.
- 40 (iii) Has been found to have violated the
- 41 provisions of this chapter or any administrative rules and
- 42 regulations adopted under this chapter, unless either ten (10)

43 ,	vears	have	passed	since	the	violation,	or	the	president	and	the

- 44 board find the violation both minor and unintentional in nature.
- 45 (iv) Is a vendor or an employee or agent of any
- 46 vendor doing business with the corporation.
- 47 (v) Resides in the same household as an officer or
- 48 board member of the corporation.
- (vi) Has made a statement of material fact to the
- 50 corporation, knowing such statement to be false.
- 51 (d) A retail liquor store shall be eligible to apply to
- 52 become a lottery retailer.
- 53 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 54 and after its passage.
