HOUSE BILL NO. 1048

- 1 AN ACT TO ESTABLISH A STATEWIDE PROGRAM FOR THE REGISTRATION OF HEMODIALYSIS TECHNICIANS UNDER THE STATE BOARD OF HEALTH; TO PRESCRIBE THE POWERS OF THE BOARD IN THE REGISTRATION OF HEMODIALYSIS TECHNICIANS; TO PROVIDE THAT HEMODIALYSIS TECHNICIANS 5 MAY ADMINISTER HEMODIALYSIS UNDER THE AUTHORITY OF A LICENSED REGISTERED NURSE; TO AUTHORIZE THE BOARD TO ESTABLISH FEES NECESSARY FOR THE ADMINISTRATION OF THIS SECTION; TO REPEAL 7 8 SECTION 73-15-101, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, WHICH PROVIDES FOR CERTIFICATION OF HEMODIALYSIS TECHNICIANS BY THE MISSISSIPPI BOARD 9 10 OF NURSING; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 12 **SECTION 1.** (1) The State Board of Health shall establish
- 13 and maintain a statewide program for the registration of
- hemodialysis technicians. 14
- 15 (2) The board is authorized and empowered to:
- Register hemodialysis technicians who meet the 16
- 17 qualifications prescribed by the board;
- 18 Maintain a permanent register of all registered
- hemodialysis technicians; and 19
- 20 (c) Adopt rules and regulations relating to the
- 21 registration and practice of hemodialysis technicians.

- 22 (3) Any person desiring registration as a registered
- 23 hemodialysis technician must submit to the State Department of
- 24 Health:
- 25 (a) An application as prescribed by the board; and
- 26 (b) A registration fee to be fixed by the board, which
- 27 shall be paid to the department.
- 28 (4) A hemodialysis technician may administer hemodialysis
- 29 under the authority of a registered nurse licensed under the
- 30 Mississippi Nursing Practice Law, who may delegate tasks based on
- 31 nursing judgment to a hemodialysis technician based on the
- 32 technician's education, knowledge, training and skills. A
- 33 hemodialysis technician who has completed or is currently in a
- 34 training program recognized by the board may perform as a
- 35 hemodialysis technician under the authority of a registered nurse
- 36 before obtaining national certification; however, the national
- 37 certification must be obtained within eighteen (18) months of the
- 38 hiring of the hemodialysis technician, and evidence of the
- 39 national certification must be provided to the department.
- 40 (5) The board shall establish fees necessary for the
- 41 administration of this section.
- 42 **SECTION 2.** Section 73-15-101, Mississippi Code of 1972,
- 43 which provides for certification of hemodialysis technicians by
- 44 the Mississippi Board of Nursing, is repealed.
- 45 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 46 and after July 1, 2019.
