## COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 1136

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 25-3-92, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 2 AUTHORIZE ADMINISTRATIVE LEAVE FOR STATE EMPLOYEES WHO ARE MEMBERS 3 OF THE MISSISSIPPI NATIONAL GUARD, THE MISSISSIPPI STATE GUARD OR 4 A RESERVE COMPONENT OF THE ARMED FORCES OF THE UNITED STATES WHO, 5 PURSUANT TO ORDERS, PERFORM DUTIES RELATED TO EMERGENCY OR 6 DISASTER RELIEF SERVICES OR ACTIVITIES; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 8 SECTION 1. Section 25-3-92, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- amended as follows: 9
- 10 25-3-92. (1) When, in the opinion of the appointing
- 11 authority, it is essential that a state employee work after normal
- working hours, the employee may receive credit for compensatory 12
- 13 leave. Except as otherwise provided in Section 37-13-89, when, in
- the opinion of the appointing authority, it is essential that a 14
- 15 state employee work during an official state holiday, the employee
- shall receive credit for compensatory leave. 16
- 17 (2) State employees may be granted administrative leave with
- 18 pay. For the purposes of this section, "administrative leave"

- means discretionary leave with pay, other than personal leave or 19
- 20 major medical leave.

- 21 (a) The appointing authority may grant administrative
- 22 leave to any employee serving as a witness or juror or party
- 23 litigant, as verified by the clerk of the court, in addition to
- 24 any fees paid for such services, and such services or necessary
- 25 appearance in any court shall not be counted as personal leave.
- 26 (b) The Governor or the appointing authority may grant
- 27 administrative leave with pay to state employees on a local or
- 28 statewide basis in the event of extreme weather conditions or in
- 29 the event of a man-made, technological or natural disaster or
- 30 emergency. Any employee on a previously approved leave during the
- 31 affected period shall be eligible for such administrative leave
- 32 granted by the Governor or appointing authority, and shall not be
- 33 charged for his previously approved leave during the affected
- 34 period.
- 35 (c) The appointing authority may grant administrative
- 36 leave with pay to any employee who is a certified disaster service
- 37 volunteer of the American Red Cross who participates in
- 38 specialized disaster relief services for the American Red Cross in
- 39 this state and in states contiguous to this state when the
- 40 American Red Cross requests the employee's participation.
- 41 Administrative leave granted under this paragraph shall not exceed
- 42 twenty (20) days in any twelve-month period. An employee on leave
- 43 under this paragraph shall not be deemed to be an employee of the
- 44 state for purposes of workers' compensation or for purposes of
- 45 claims against the state allowed under Chapter 46, Title 11,

- 46 Mississippi Code of 1972. As used in this paragraph, the term
- 47 "disaster" includes disasters designated at Level II and above in
- 48 American Red Cross national regulations and procedures.
- 49 (d) The appointing authority may grant administrative
- 100 leave with pay to any employee who is a member of the Mississippi
- 51 National Guard, the Mississippi State Guard or a reserve component
- 52 of the Armed Forces of the United States who, pursuant to orders,
- 53 performs duties related to emergency or disaster relief services
- 54 or activities. Administrative leave granted under this paragraph
- 55 (d) shall not exceed twenty (20) days in any twelve-month period.
- 56 An employee on leave under this paragraph (d) shall not be deemed
- 57 to be an employee of the state for purposes of workers'
- 58 compensation or for purposes of claims against the state allowed
- 59 under Chapter 46, Title 11, Mississippi Code of 1972. For the
- 60 purposes of this paragraph (d), the term "Mississippi National
- 61 Guard" means and has the same definition as that term has in
- 62 Section 33-1-1, and the term "Mississippi State Guard" means the
- 63 Mississippi State Guard organized under Section 33-5-51. For the
- 64 purposes of this paragraph (d), the term "reserve component" of
- 65 the Armed Forces of the United States means the Army National
- 66 Guard, the Army National Guard of the United States, the Air
- 67 National Guard or the Air National Guard of the United States, as
- 68 those terms are defined in 10 USCS 101, and any other reserve
- 69 component of the United States Armed Forces enumerated in Section
- 70 10 USCS 10101.

71 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from

72 and after July 1, 2019.
