## HOUSE BILL NO. 1226

- 1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 73-21-126, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 2 TO AUTHORIZE THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY TO CONDUCT CRIMINAL 3 HISTORY RECORDS CHECKS ON ALL APPLICANTS FOR LICENSES FOR IN- AND 4 OUT-OF-STATE WHOLESALE DISTRIBUTORS, CHAIN PHARMACY WAREHOUSES AND 5 REPACKAGERS SHIPPING INTO MISSISSIPPI; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6
- 7 SECTION 1. Section 73-21-126, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 8 amended as follows:
- 9 73-21-126. (1) The State Board of Pharmacy shall promulgate
- 10 rules regarding the issuance and renewal of licenses and permits
- for new or renewal application requirements for both in- and 11
- 12 out-of-state wholesale distributors, chain pharmacy warehouses and
- repackagers shipping into Mississippi. Requirements for new 13
- 14 and/or renewal applications, if information has not been
- 15 previously provided to the board, will include, but not be limited
- 16 to, the following:
- 17 (a) Type of ownership (individual, partnership or
- corporation); 18

19	(b) Names of principal owners or officers and social
20	security numbers;
21	(c) Names of designated representatives and social
22	security numbers;
23	(d) Criminal background checks of applicants and
24	designated representatives as required by rule;
25	(e) Copy of license in home state;
26	(f) Bond requirements.
27	(2) To ensure that all applicants are of good moral
28	character, the board shall conduct a criminal history records
29	check on all applicants for a license. In order to determine the
30	applicant's suitability for licensing, the applicant shall be
31	fingerprinted. The board shall submit the fingerprints to the
32	Department of Public Safety for a check of the state criminal
33	records and forwarded to the Federal Bureau of Investigation for a
34	check of the national criminal records. The Department of Public
35	Safety shall disseminate the results of the state check and the
36	national check to the board for a suitability determination. The
37	board shall be authorized to collect from the applicant the amount
38	of the fee that the Department of Public Safety charges the board
39	for the fingerprinting, whether manual or electronic, and the
40	state and national criminal history records checks.
41	(3) The board shall promulgate rules for the establishment
42	of a pedigree or electronic file to be used by wholesale
43	distributors, chain pharmacy warehouses and repackagers for the

- 44 purpose of ensuring the integrity of drugs owned, purchased,
- 45 distributed, returned, transferred and sold when the products
- 46 leave the normal distribution channel.
- 47 ( \* \* \*4) The board is authorized to use an outside agency
- 48 to accredit wholesale distributors and repackagers, including the
- 49 National Association of Boards of Pharmacy's (NABP) Verified
- 50 Accredited Wholesale Distributors (VAWD) program.
- 51 (\* \* \*5) Pharmacies shall not be responsible for
- 52 verification or adjudication of the pedigree for pharmaceuticals.
- 53 (\* \* \*6) The board may exempt wholesalers accredited by the
- 54 VAWD program from the above requirements.
- 55 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 56 and after July 1, 2019.
