HOUSE BILL NO. 1363

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 57-46-1, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REVISE THE USE OF THE MISSISSIPPI RAILROAD IMPROVEMENTS FUND TO PROVIDE THAT GRANTS FROM THE FUND SHALL BE AVAILABLE SPECIFICALLY TO SHORT LINE RAILROADS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6 SECTION 1. Section 57-46-1, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 7 amended as follows:

8 57-46-1. (1) (a) There is created a special fund in the 9 State Treasury to be known as the Mississippi Railroad 10 Improvements Fund which shall consist of monies from any source designated for deposit into the fund. Unexpended amounts 11 12 remaining in the fund at the end of a fiscal year shall not lapse 13 into the State General Fund, and any investment earnings or 14 interest earned on amounts in the fund shall be deposited to the credit of the fund. Monies in the fund shall be disbursed by the 15 16 Mississippi Development Authority (MDA) for the purposes 17 authorized in subsection (2) of this section.

18 (b) Monies in the fund that are derived from the19 proceeds of general obligation bonds may be used to reimburse

An accounting of actual costs incurred for 23 which reimbursement is sought shall be maintained for each grant by the MDA. Reimbursement of reasonable actual and necessary 24 25 costs for assistance shall not exceed three percent (3%) of the proceeds of bonds issued for such assistance. Reimbursements made 26 27 under this subsection shall satisfy any applicable federal tax law 28 requirements.

(2) The MDA shall establish a program to make grants to short line railroads from the Mississippi Railroad Improvements Fund to assist in paying a portion of the costs associated with the repair, rehabilitation, construction, reconstruction, upgrading and improvement of railroad lines and related facilities, including projects necessary to ensure safety and structural integrity of rail lines, rail beds and bridges.

(b) The MDA shall have sole discretion in providing
grants under this section. The terms of a grant shall be within
the discretion of the MDA.

47 (4) The MDA shall have all powers necessary to implement and 48 administer the program established under this section, including 49 the establishing of requirements for matching funds and criteria 50 regarding the evaluation of applications for assistance. The MDA shall promulgate rules and regulations, in accordance with the 51 52 Mississippi Administrative Procedures Law, necessary for the 53 implementation and administration of this section.

54 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 55 and after July 1, 2019.
