- (10) (a) After a determination by the court of the amount due, it shall be the duty of the clerk of the court to promptly collect all state assessments imposed under the provisions of this section. The state assessments imposed under the provisions of this section may not be paid by personal check.
- 252 (b) It shall be the duty of the chancery clerk of each 253 county to deposit all state assessments collected in the circuit, 254 county and justice courts in the county on a monthly basis with 255 the State Treasurer pursuant to appropriate procedures established 256 by the State Auditor. The chancery clerk shall make a monthly 257 lump-sum deposit of the total state assessments collected in the 258 circuit, county and justice courts in the county under this 259 section, and shall report to the Department of Finance and 260 Administration the total number of violations under each 261 subsection for which state assessments were collected in the 262 circuit, county and justice courts in the county during that 263 month.
- (c) It shall be the duty of the municipal clerk of each municipality to deposit all the state assessments collected in the municipal court in the municipality on a monthly basis with the

267 State Treasurer pursuant to appropriate procedures established by 268 the State Auditor. The municipal clerk shall make a monthly 269 lump-sum deposit of the total state assessments collected in the 270 municipal court in the municipality under this section, and shall 271 report to the Department of Finance and Administration the total 272 number of violations under each subsection for which state 273 assessments were collected in the municipal court in the 274 municipality during that month.

- (11) It shall be the duty of the Department of Finance and Administration to deposit on a monthly basis all state assessments into the State General Fund or proper special fund in the State Treasury. The Department of Finance and Administration shall issue regulations providing for the proper allocation of these funds.
- 281 (12)The State Auditor shall establish by regulation 282 procedures for refunds of state assessments, including refunds 283 associated with assessments imposed before July 1, 1990, and 284 refunds after appeals in which the defendant's conviction is 285 reversed. The Auditor shall provide in the regulations for 286 certification of eligibility for refunds and may require the 287 defendant seeking a refund to submit a verified copy of a court 288 order or abstract by which the defendant is entitled to a refund. 289 All refunds of state assessments shall be made in accordance with 290 the procedures established by the Auditor.

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291 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 292 and after July 1, 2019.
