HOUSE BILL NO. 1618 (As Sent to Governor)

1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FROM SPECIAL FUNDS IN THE 2 STATE TREASURY FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE ADMINISTRATIVE 3 EXPENSES OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE PUBLIC EMPLOYEES' 4 RETIREMENT SYSTEM AND FOR THE MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION OF THE 5 RETIREMENT SYSTEM BUILDING FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2020. 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 7 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 8 necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the Administrative Expense Account of the Public 10 Employees' Retirement System for the purpose of defraying the administrative expenses of the Board of Trustees of the Public 11 12 Employees' Retirement System, or out of any money in the State 13 Treasury to the credit of the Retirement System Building Account of the Public Employees' Retirement System for the purpose of 14 15 maintenance and general operation of the Retirement System Building, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2019, and ending 16 June 30, 2020.....\$ 16,114,043.00. 17 SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of 18 19 Section 1, the following positions are authorized:

25	With the funds	herein appropriated, it shall be the agency's
26	responsibility to ma	ake certain that funds required to be
27	appropriated for "Pe	ersonal Services" for Fiscal Year 2021 do not
28	exceed Fiscal Year 2	2020 funds appropriated for that purpose,
29	unless programs or p	positions are added to the agency's Fiscal Year
30	2020 budget by the I	Mississippi Legislature. Based on data
31	provided by the Lega	islative Budget Office, the State Personnel
32	Board shall determin	ne and publish the projected annual cost to

- Funds are provided herein for all full-time employees to
- 48 receive up to a Three Percent (3%) pay increase to the realignment
- 49 component of the Variable Compensation Plan, excluding head of
- 50 agencies, board members and commission members.
- Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
- 52 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or
- 53 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State
- 54 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written
- 55 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The
- 56 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
- 57 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions
- 58 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
- 59 appropriated level.
- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 61 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 62 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 63 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- None of the funds herein appropriated shall be used in
- 65 violation of Internal Revenue Service's Publication 15-A relating
- 66 to the reporting of income paid to contract employees, as
- 67 interpreted by the Office of the State Auditor.
- 68 **SECTION 3.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 69 Board of Trustees of the Public Employees' Retirement System shall

- 70 maintain complete accounting and personnel records related to the
- 71 expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such
- 72 records shall be in the same format and level of detail as
- 73 maintained for Fiscal Year 2019. It is further the intention of
- 74 the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year
- 75 2021 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee
- 76 in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level
- 77 of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2020 budget request
- 78 process.
- 79 **SECTION 4.** In accordance with the purposes of this article,
- 80 there shall be established in the State Treasury the Public
- 81 Employees' Retirement System Building Repair and Maintenance Fund,
- 82 into which shall be deposited all funds collected as rental income
- 83 from the building owned by the system located at 301 North
- 84 President Street, Jackson, Mississippi. At the end of each fiscal
- 85 year, any and all unexpended funds shall be transferred to the
- 86 Administrative Budget Fund of the system.
- 87 **SECTION 5.** It is the intention of the Legislature that
- 88 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the
- 89 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things
- 90 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,
- 91 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind
- 92 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to
- 93 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are
- 94 made without competitive bids.

95	SECTION 6. In addition to all other sums herein		
96	appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be		
97	necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the State Treasury		
98	to the credit of the Administrative Expense Account of the Public		
99	Employees' Retirement System, for the purpose of defraying those		
100	expenses associated with a replacement computer system, for the		
101	fiscal year beginning July 1, 2019, and ending June 30, 2020		
102	\$ 3,900,000.00.		
103	SECTION 7. The Public Employees' Retirement System is		
104	further authorized, in its discretion, to expend funds for the		
105	purchase of service pins for employees of the Public Employees'		
106	Retirement System.		
107	SECTION 8. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1, no more		
108	than Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$300,000.00) is provided,		
109	only for the explicit purpose of building maintenance and repair.		
110	SECTION 9. It is the intention of the Legislature that the		
111	funds herein appropriated shall be expended in compliance with		
112	Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, that no state agency		
113	shall incur obligations or indebtedness in excess of their		
114	appropriation and that the responsible officers, either personall		
115	or upon their official bonds, shall be held responsible for		
116	actions contrary to this provision.		
117	SECTION 10. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by		
118	the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the		

credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon

120	warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
121	Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
122	proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law
123	SECTION 11. This act shall take effect and be in force from
124	and after July 1, 2019.
