6	SECTION 1. Th	e following sum, or so much th	hereof as may be

19	with the funds herein appropriated, it shall be the agency's
20	responsibility to make certain that funds required to be
21	appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2021 do not
22	exceed Fiscal Year 2020 funds appropriated for that purpose,
23	unless programs or positions are added to the agency's Fiscal Year
24	2020 budget by the Mississippi Legislature. Based on data
25	provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel
26	Board shall determine and publish the projected annual cost to
27	fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with the
28	provisions of this act. It shall be the responsibility of the
29	agency head to ensure that no single personnel action increases
30	this projected annual cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2020
31	appropriations for "Personal Services" when annualized, with the
32	exception of escalated funds and the award of benchmarks. If, at
33	the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal
34	Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency
35	has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this
36	projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2020 "Personal Services"
37	appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which
38	reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation
39	requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until
40	such time as the requirements of this provision are met.
41	Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
42	the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or
43	allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State

- 44 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written
- 45 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The
- 46 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
- 47 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions
- 48 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
- 49 appropriated level.
- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 51 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 52 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 53 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- None of the funds herein appropriated shall be used in
- 55 violation of Internal Revenue Service's Publication 15-A relating
- 56 to the reporting of income paid to contract employees, as
- 57 interpreted by the Office of the State Auditor.
- SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 59 Mississippi State Board of Physical Therapy shall maintain
- 60 complete accounting and personnel records related to the
- 61 expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such
- 62 records shall be in the same format and level of detail as
- 63 maintained for Fiscal Year 2019. It is further the intention of
- 64 the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year
- 65 2021 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee
- 66 in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level
- 67 of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2020 budget request
- 68 process.

69	SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that
70	whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the
71	purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things
72	stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,
73	quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind
74	shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to
75	the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are
76	made without competitive bids.

- SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
 funds herein appropriated shall be expended in compliance with
 Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, that no state agency
 shall incur obligations or indebtedness in excess of their
 appropriation and that the responsible officers, either personally
 or upon their official bonds, shall be held responsible for
 actions contrary to this provision.
- SECTION 6. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
- 90 **SECTION 7.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 91 and after July 1, 2019.
