L 9	responsibility to make certain that funds required to be

- 129 **SECTION 9.** Within the limits of the funds available to the
- 130 Mississippi Insurance Department for such purpose, the

- 132 may grant a paid internship to students pursuing junior or senior
- 133 undergraduate level year coursework toward a bachelor's degree in

142	SECTION 10. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1, Two
143	Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000.00) is provided for the
144	State Fire Marshal's Office for fire safety prevention and
145	services, including, but not limited to, fire protection supplies
146	and materials, smoke alarms, and public service announcements
147	providing fire prevention information.
148	SECTION 11. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
149	necessary and contingent upon the passage of HB 444, 2019 Regular
150	Session, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special
151	fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Rural Fire Truck
152	Acquisition Assistance Fund and/or the Supplemental Rural Fire
153	Truck Fund, which was created in Section 1, Laws of 2004, Third
154	Extraordinary Session, to the Mississippi Department of Insurance
155	for the Rural Fire Truck Acquisition Assistance Program for the
156	fiscal year beginning July 1, 2019, and ending June 30, 2020
157	\$ 3,500,000.00
158	Of this amount, One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars
159	(\$150,000.00) shall be used for the purchase of a fire truck for

172	SECTION 13. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
173	the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
174	credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
175	warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
176	Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
177	proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
178	SECTION 14. This act shall take effect and be in force from
179	and after July 1, 2019.
