5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the State General
7	Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of defraying the
8	expenses of the State Fire Academy for the fiscal year beginning
9	July 1, 2019, and ending June 30, 2020
10	\$ 5,230,230.00.
11	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
12	necessary, is hereby authorized for expenditure out of any special
13	source funds which are collected by or otherwise become available,
14	for the support and maintenance of the State Fire Academy for the
15	fiscal year beginning July 1, 2019, and ending June 30, 2020

83	SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that the		
84	State Fire Academy shall maintain complete accounting and		
85	personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds		
86	appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the		
87	same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year		
88	2019. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the		
89	agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2021 shall be submitted to		
90	the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of		
91	detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided		
92	during the Fiscal Year 2020 budget request process.		

SECTION 6. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of Section 2, One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00), or so much thereof, shall be derived out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the Capital Expense Fund, as created in Section 27-103-303, Mississippi Code of 1972, and allocated in a manner as determined by the Treasurer's Office. These funds are provided for matching grant funds for an Airport Firefighter Crash Truck.

whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind shall be given preference. SECTION 8. It is the intention of the Legislature that the funds herein appropriated shall be expended in compliance with Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, that no state agency shall incur obligations or indebtedness in excess of their appropriation and that the responsible officers, either personally or upon their official bonds, shall be held responsible for actions contrary to this provision.

SECTION 9. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
