1 2 3	AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE SUPPORT AND MAINTENANCE OF THE MISSISSIPPI LIBRARY COMMISSION FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2020.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the State General
7	Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the support and maintenance
8	of the Mississippi Library Commission and for carrying out the
9	provisions of Section 39-3-107, Mississippi Code of 1972, for the
10	fiscal year beginning July 1, 2019, and ending June 30, 2020
11	\$ 9,438,152.00.
12	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
13	necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the special fund in
14	the State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Library
15	Commission which is comprised of special source funds collected by
16	or otherwise available to the commission, for the purpose of
17	defraying the expenses of the commission for the fiscal year
18	beginning July 1, 2019, and ending June 30, 2020

19	\$ 3,462,685.00.
20	SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
21	this act, the following positions are authorized:
22	AUTHORIZED POSITIONS:
23	Permanent: Full Time 48
24	Part Time 0
25	Time-Limited: Full Time 0
26	Part Time 0
27	With the funds herein appropriated, it shall be the agency's
28	responsibility to make certain that funds required to be
29	appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2021 do not
30	exceed Fiscal Year 2020 funds appropriated for that purpose,
31	unless programs or positions are added to the agency's Fiscal Year
32	2020 budget by the Mississippi Legislature. Based on data
33	provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel
34	Board shall determine and publish the projected annual cost to
35	fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with the
36	provisions of this act. It shall be the responsibility of the
37	agency head to ensure that no single personnel action increases
38	this projected annual cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2020
39	appropriations for "Personal Services" when annualized, with the
40	exception of escalated funds and the award of benchmarks. If, at
41	the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal
42	Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency
43	has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this

- 44 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2020 "Personal Services"
- 45 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which
- 46 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation
- 47 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until
- 48 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.
- Funds are provided herein for all full-time employees to
- 50 receive up to a Three Percent (3%) pay increase to the realignment
- 51 component of the Variable Compensation Plan, excluding head of
- 52 agencies, board members and commission members.
- Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
- 54 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or
- 55 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State
- 56 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written
- 57 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The
- 58 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
- 59 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions
- 60 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
- 61 appropriated level.
- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 63 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 64 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 65 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- None of the funds herein appropriated shall be used in
- 67 violation of Internal Revenue Service's Publication 15-A relating

- 68 to the reporting of income paid to contract employees, as
- 69 interpreted by the Office of the State Auditor.
- 70 Funds to be distributed to eligible public library systems
- 71 under the Personnel Incentive Grants Program shall be paid
- 72 quarterly in advance on or before September 30, December 31, March
- 73 31 and June 30.
- 74 **SECTION 4.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 75 Mississippi Library Commission shall maintain complete accounting
- 76 and personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds
- 77 appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the
- 78 same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year
- 79 2019. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the
- 80 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2021 shall be submitted to
- 81 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of
- 82 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided
- 83 during the Fiscal Year 2020 budget request process.
- 84 **SECTION 5.** Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
- 85 Section 2, Four Hundred Ninety-three Thousand Eight Hundred
- 86 Forty-seven Dollars (\$493,847.00) shall be derived from the
- 87 Education Enhancement Fund deposited pursuant to Sections 27-65-75
- 88 and 27-67-31, Mississippi Code of 1972.
- 89 **SECTION 6.** In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance
- 90 Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the intent of
- 91 the Legislature that the funds provided herein shall be utilized
- 92 in the most efficient and effective manner possible to achieve the

93	intended mission of this agency. Based on the funding authorized,
94	this agency shall make every effort to attain the targeted
95	performance measures provided below:

118	set above have been or are being achieved shall be provided in the
119	agency's budget request submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget
120	Committee for Fiscal Year 2021.
121	SECTION 7. It is the intention of the Legislature that no
122	less than One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) shall be expended
123	for the Magnolia Database.
124	SECTION 8. Of the funds appropriated herein, Three Million
125	Five Hundred Fifty-five Thousand Seven Hundred Seventy-nine
126	Dollars (\$3,555,779.00) is provided for the cost of health
127	insurance for all full-time library staff members in each public
128	library in Mississippi.
129	SECTION 9. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, the
130	following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby
131	appropriated out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit
132	of the Capital Expense Fund, and allocated in a manner as
133	determined by the State Treasurer, to defray the expenses of the
134	Library Commission for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2019, and
135	ending June 30, 2020\$476,654.00.
136	SECTION 10. It is the intention of the Legislature that
137	whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the
138	purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things
139	stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,
140	quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind
141	shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to

142	the Mississippi	Industries	for	the	Blind	whenever	purchases	are
143	made without com	npetitive bi	lds.					

144	SECTION 11. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
145	funds herein appropriated shall be expended in compliance with
146	Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, that no state agency
147	shall incur obligations or indebtedness in excess of their
148	appropriation and that the responsible officers, either personally
149	or upon their official bonds, shall be held responsible for
150	actions contrary to this provision.

- SECTION 12. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
- SECTION 13. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2019.

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
